Markham engineer goes to Niagara

MARKHAM - A well known Markham resident and widely experienced Ontario Hydro engineer, J.W.H. 'Bill' Kerr, Station Maintenance Superintendent for Central Region, has been appointed Station Superintendent for the Commission's Sir Adam Beck Niagara Generating Stations.

Bill Kerr and his wife, Edna, have two children, John, age 21, and Ann, age 19, both of whom attended Markham Dist. High School and are now students at Western University in London. The Kerr family recently moved from Markham to Niagara Falls.

In 21 years with the Commission, Bill Kerr has served in many positions, including Area Manager in four Areas in Central Region.

A Torontonian by birth, Bill Kerr attended Lawrence Park Collegiate before enrolling at the University of Toronto. He graduated from university in 1946 with a B.A. Sc., in Engineering.

Joining Hydro in 1951 as a junior engineer in Central

Region he soon moved to Brampton Area as a junior engineer. One year later he transferred to Sutton Area as Area Manager and he remained there for three years prior to his next move which saw him assume the Area Manager's position in Markham Area. His tenure in Markham was six years, and then it was in to Central Region Office as Consumer Service Supervisor. Head Office beckoned one year later, and he moved to the Rural and Municipal Service Departments for one and one-half years.

Mr. Kerr's next move took him back to Brampton Area, but this time as Area Manager. After one year in Brampton he was transferred to Lakefront Area as Area Manager and he held that position six years until he became Regional Station Maintenance Superintendent two years ago.

Prior to joining Ontario Hydro's staff, Bill Kerr had carried out research work in gold mines in northern Ontario and also in northern British Columbia. Later he was an apparatus sales engineer with Canadian General Electric Co., in Toronto and Montreal before coming to the Commission's staff in the spring of 1951.

For the past three seasons he has served as President of the Ontario Hydro Provincial Curling Association, and he is a charter member and past President of the Whitevale Golf Club, and a member of the Unionville Curling Club for the past 10 years.

Money likeness - a crime

Increased reproduction of Canada paper currency likenesses in pictures and advertising has made it necessary for the authorities to stop their practice of warning printers and publishers.

From now on charges will be laid where circumstances warrant, says OPP Public Information Inspector Fred Blucher in a press

release this week. "The OPP Anti Rackets Branch is concerned with the ever increasing trend on the part of the advertising and printing media to reproduce the likeness of Canadian paper currency in commercial advertising and other printed material. While such reproductions cheapen the position of bank notes in the public eye, many of the formats used are in contravention of the Criminal Code.

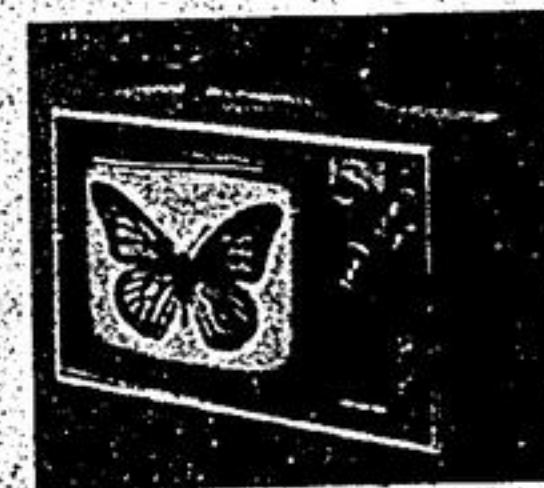
"The section of the code dealing with this subject reads in part, 'Everyone who publishes or prints anything in the likeness or appearance of all or part of a current bank note or all or part of any obligation or security of a government or bank, is guilty of an offense.'"

says Blucher.
