

## Almost 800 cars stopped in first week of police checks

YORK REGION - York Regional Police stopped 799 vehicles - including 452 last weekend - in their first week of holiday safety spot checks. The campaign resulted in 13 drivers being charged under the Highway Traffic Act and 42 being given 72 hours to have faulty equipment repaired. Chief Bruce Crawford said the spot checks will continue indefinitely. The crackdown represents a police effort to decrease the number of traffic accidents during the holiday period. Already this year 33 persons have died on York Region roads, three more than in 1971, the chief noted.

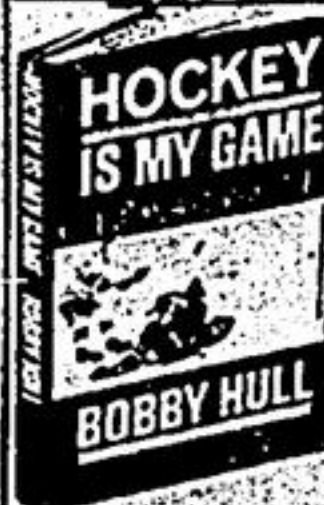

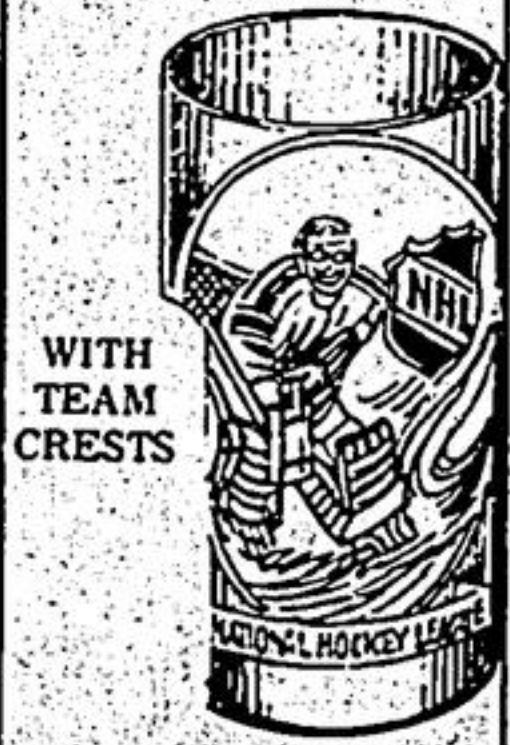
