Spirit can move into 4th with win at home tonight

Cousins net two goals each in fight-filled win over Terriers

The Stouffville Spirit picked up two points and some valuable tips Thursday as they head towards next month's Provincial Jr. A Hockey League playoffs.

The Spirit doubled the Couchiching Terriers, the team they will most likely meet in the first round, 6-3 in front of 231 fans at the Stouffville Arena.

In winning their second straight game and sixth of its last eight outings, the fifth-place Spirit (26-12-4) trails the Terriers (27-13-4) by just two points with two games in hand. Aurora was three points ahead of Couchiching before hosting Newmarket last night.

The Spirit won the regular season with the Terriers four games to two.

FORTY-NINE PENALTIES, FOUR FIGHTS

In Thursday's contest, emotions were high with referee Dave Koziel busy calling 49 penalties, included four fights.

"We have to stay disciplined but still be able to protect our goalie and stick up for each other," third year Spirit forward Mark Sullivan said. "And we have to keep putting up the numbers."

Sullivan, his cousin Pat McEachen and Corey Trivino had two goals each for the Spirit.

Ethan Werek and Daniel Spivak had two-assist games. Trevor O'Neill earned his 21st win of the season.

Matt Smyth had two goals and an assist for Couchiching, and exhibited why he was a first-round Ontario Hock-

ey League draft pick three years ago.

The Florida native, who played minor hockey for the Markham Islanders, was with Brampton and Sarnia in the OHL during the last three seasons before being demoted at mid-season.

The Spirit hosts Seguin tonight at 7:30 p.m. at the Stouffville Arena, while Couchiching has the weekend off.

HOST SEGUIN BRUINS TONIGHT

The regular season ends Feb. 13. The top teams in each conference (Huntsville and Newmarket in the North, if the season ended today) receive first-round byes this year, with teams in third through sixth place meeting in best-of-five series in the first round.

The Spirit is in Newmarket Tuesday night to make up a game postponed due to bad weather last month.

Trivino and James McIntosh played in the league all-star game Wednesday in Vaughan on the North-West team that defeated the South-East entry 4-3. Trivino, a late replacement for the injured Randy Johnston, collected an assist.

Earlier that day, recently-acquired Spirit defenceman Ryan Goldberg played for the North-South squad in the junior all-star game and scored the lone marker in an 8-1 loss. Also playing for the North-South squad were McEachen and forward Dustin Laren. The league recently announced its award winners for the 2007-08 regular season. Werek was named the North Conference's Rookie of the Year.
