

SDSS teams to semis

For the Stouffville District Secondary School Spartans senior boys' hockey team, it's on to the York Region Athletic Association semifinals.

The Spartans captured their first-to-three-points quarter-final series over Keswick Secondary School three points to none, capping it off Thursday with a 3-1 win at Stouffville Arena.

Scott Van Allen's goal with about seven minutes remaining in regulation time proved to be the winner.

Matt Raguseo scored the first goal for the Spartans, who battled Keswick to a 0-0 tie through one period and 1-1 after two. Jamie Wise added an insurance goal in an empty net.

The Spartans won the first game of the series Wednesday in Keswick 5-4, almost blowing a four-goal lead.

Van Allen led the Spartans' with two goals while Raguseo, Paul Geiger and Malcolm Forbes added singles.

"We started out well Wednesday, but we stopped skating and held on," Spartans head coach Jamie Hewitt said of the first game. "We didn't have one of our better games on Thursday, but we played well enough."

The Spartans will play St. Theresa of Lisieux Catholic High School (Richmond Hill) in the semifinals.

The opener of the first-to-three-point series goes Tues-

day at the Stouffville Arena at 1 p.m.

The winner plays the victor of the Markham District High School and Brother Andre Catholic High School semifinal series in the final.
