
Final all-star game for Jim

Silverthorn makes waves for Ducks in Guelph meet

Jake Silverthorn led an 11-member contingent from the Stouffville Swim Club at the recent BDO Dunwoody Invitational in Guelph by claiming six medals and posting 100-per-cent best times in each of his events.

The 12-year-old Stouffville competitor swam off with gold in the male 11-12 200-metre backstroke and freestyle, silver in the 100m free, 200m individual medley and 100m backstroke and bronze in 50m free-

Silverthorn also qualified for two more provincial standards, bringing his total to six.

Making her debut with the Ducks, Gloria Lai, 14, made finals in every race and came away with one silver in the female 13-14 100m freestyle, one bronze in the 50m freestyle, one sixth and one seventh.

Kevin Boehnke, 16, achieved three bronze medals in the male 15 and over 100m ad 200m breaststroke and 200m individual medley, one fifth and two sixths, while getting two personal bests.

Jaime Silverthorn, 10, achieved three best times and got one bronze in the female 10 and under 50m freestyle, one fourth, one fifth and two sevenths.

Dylan Cook, 12, swam all personal bests and was awarded one sixth, three sevenths and one eighth.

Bethany Philpott, 17, received three sixths, one seventh and two eighths. Alexandria Krawczuk, 12, swam off with five best times and placed sixth in her 50m freestyle.

Alison Romano, 13, attained five best times and made finals in the 200m individual medley.

Krista Bradshaw, 13, swam off with five personal bests, while Caleigh Stallybrass, 13, and Cassandra Roberts, 12, each had four.
