

Arena, fire hall could still open on time

Special council meeting Monday on delay

A special Whitchurch-Stouffville council meeting to decide on Stouffville's new fire hall and arena has been scheduled for Monday at 3 p.m.

A decision on the two projects was put off at last week's meeting after politicians requested more information.

You are welcome to attend.

If politicians give the go-ahead for the projects Monday, the arena doors and the fire hall could open in the fall of 2009, but construction would have to

flow smoothly.

The tender for construction of the buildings closes in July and about 12 to 14 months are needed for building.

Both are to be built on Weldon Road, between Stouffville District Secondary School and Sobeys.

If council doesn't give the go-ahead Monday, "we won't have ice until 2010", Mayor Wayne Emmerson said.

"I support what the staff have brought forward," he said.

The arena will cost \$17.1 million, all paid by development charges.

The fire station price tag comes in at \$5.9 million. Development charges will pay for about 60 percent of the cost.

At last week's meeting, Councillor


Clyde Smith suggested the buildings meet the environmental standards set by the LEEDS program (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design green building rating system). This standard has been incorporated into the projects.

The municipality may be the only one in the area building an arena at this time, Mr. Emmerson said.

Some nearby municipalities have already completed rinks.


