

Spartans take Trent tourney, snap curse

The Stouffville District Secondary School Spartans senior boys' rugby team tuned up for defence of its Ontario and York Region championships by winning the Trent University Invitational Monday in Peterborough, climaxed with a 7-0 win over Adam Scott Collegiate.

Jamie Gregory scored the game's lone try and Matt Raguseo, who was named the tournament's MVP, added the convert.

Raguseo is part of the national team program.

Opening the tournament against Thomas A Stewart and playing in a downpour, the Spartans cruised to a 14-3 win. Raguseo accounted for all of the points with a pair of tries and two converts.

RAGUSEO STARS IN VICTORIES

Facing Trenton High School in their second game, the Spartans overcame an 11-0 deficit and got a try from Raguseo on the final play of the match to emerge with a 14-11 win and a berth in the final.

Raguseo also scored one other try and booted two converts.

Last week in Lindsay, the Spartans broke a curse by defeating Lindsay Collegiate Institute for the first time ever in an exhibition tilt 19-12.

The victory snapped a seven-game losing streak spanning six years.

"Last year, we lost to them twice," Spartans head coach Jamie Hewitt said. "But this year, our players were looking forward to playing them. Lindsay is a very good team and the game was well played."

Raguseo scored two tries and booted two converts and Kyle Miller added the other try.

BOEUTCHER LEADS JUNIORS

In other rugby action, the Spartans juniors took to the pitch last week for an exhibition tilt against I.E. Weldon Secondary School and prevailed 15-0.

Oliver Boeutcher scored all three tries for the Spartans.
