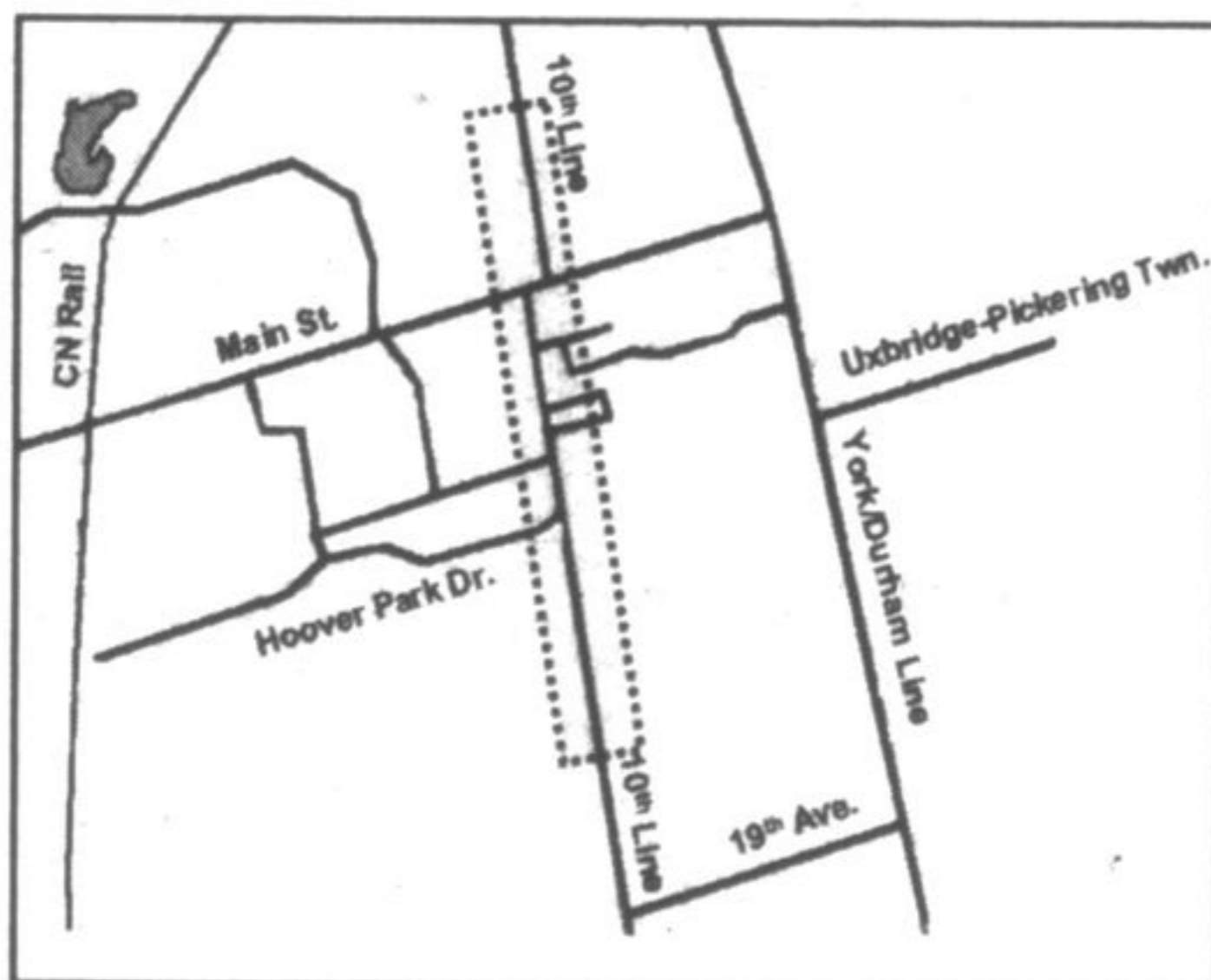

NOTICE OF STUDY COMPLETION CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT - TENTH LINE IMPROVEMENTS



The Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville has completed the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) Study for Tenth Line Improvements. The study area included a 3 km section of Tenth Line; from the southern boundary of the Town to Forsyth Farm Drive north of Main Street. The preferred design is a two-lane urban cross-section, with an 11.0m pavement width, storm sewers, bicycle lane, sidewalks, illumination and landscaping.

The study was conducted as a **Schedule C** undertaking in accordance with the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment, June 2000, (amended in 2007), which is an approved process under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act. The Environmental Study Report (ESR) has been prepared to document the planning and decision making processes followed. By this notice, the ESR is being placed on public record for a 30 calendar day review period beginning May 8th, 2008. If concerns cannot be resolved through discussions with the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville, a person may request the Minister of the Environment issue a Part II Order for this project. A Part II Order request must be received by the Minister at the address below no later than 4:30 pm (local time) on June 9th, 2008. A copy of the request must also be sent to the Town Clerk. If no request is received within the 30-day public review period, the project will proceed to detailed design and construction as outlined in the ESR.
