


they soon However, bounce back.

Since much of the Schell Building Centres' business comes from the construction trade, and with an increasing population, there's room for both the big box and his stores, Mr. Schell said.

"Our strength is basically service," said Mr. Schell, who runs the business, including the Schell Country Depot and Design Centre, with his cousin, Steve Schell.

"We are trying to be like the old stores where we can serve you," Mr. Schell said.

Customers can come

in for a few nails or screws, for instance, without having to take several dozen in a package, have custom orders done, get advice from the knowledgeable tool guys working there and receive free delivery.

Pricing is also kept in line with competing hardware and building stores, he said.

The country depot caters to local farmers, while the design centre carries a full complement of flooring, windows, doors and more.

"There are still a lot of farmers and hobby farmers around," Mr. Schell said.
