The anticipated start date for Construction is June, 2008, with completion in August, 2008.

The project involves the earthworks and area grading for the site to set it to a pre-grade elevation, as well as storm sewers, sanitary sewers and water mains. The works to be completed under the contract include but are not limited to:

- Sedimentation and Erosion Control
- Install new storm sewer system required to take the drainage from the Sobey's site to the north
- Adjust alignment of the existing ditch at the north west corner of the site
- Decommission the existing storm water management ponds within the property
- Remove the existing structures and features within the site
- Complete the stripping, area grading and mass earthworks within the site to establish the pre-grade elevations. The pre-grade elevations shall be derived from subtracting the balance line elevations from the finished grades as identified on the site grading plan
- Construct proposed sanitary sewers, storm sewers and water mains including connections
- Preparation of dry pond area as well as overland flow route to Mostar Road

OUTDOOR WATER USE FOR THE COMMUNITIES OF STOUFFVILLE, BALLANTRAE & MUSSELMAN'S LAKE WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM

No person shall use the municipal water of the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville from a hose, pipe, sprinkler or permanent water irrigation system for the purpose of watering any lawn, garden or the washing of vehicles, sidewalks or driveways or the filling of swimming pools except as follows:

- a) An EVEN numbered address may use water outdoors ONLY ON EVEN NUMBERED DAYS of the month;
- b) An ODD numbered address may use water outdoors ONLY ON ODD NUMBERED DAYS of the month;
- c) **Outdoor water use is only permitted between the hours of 6:00 am to 10:00 am and 6:00 pm to 10:00 pm.** This use of municipal water from a hose, pipe sprinkler or permanent water irrigation system outside these periods is a contravention of the by-law.
- d) That these conditions be in place between May 15th and September 30th of each year;
- e) Exemptions are provided in Schedule "A".
