300 new trees to help animals

Animals in the Willowgrove community could be a happier bunch, now that staff and students at Willowgrove Primary School planted more than 300 trees in the area.

The planting, done with family and friends, creates a nature corridor connecting Willowgrove Creek and ponds to a 25-acre forest on McCowan Road south of Stouffville Road.

With the help of Ballantrae Public School and the Community Resource Centre of Scarborough, Willowgrove has added four acres of habitat to the Rouge watershed.

This new corridor allows animals privacy and comfort away from human activities so they can travel between wetland and woodland habitats.

The long-term goal is to help animals travel north from Rouge Park to the Oak Ridges Moraine.
