

# Mennos hand champs first loss of season

The Stouffville Mennos handed the defending Oshawa City and District Fastball League champion Oshawa Ravens their first loss of the season with a 2-1 win Thursday at Memorial Park.

The Mennos inflicted all of their damage in the first inning when Rich Burkholder singled and advanced to second when Byron Baranieski drew a walk. After both runners advanced on a wild pitch, Mennos' shortstop Jeff Boadway drilled a double to score both runners.

Greg Delgarno tossed the first five innings and earned the win. Baranieski worked the final two innings to pick up the save.

Helping to preserve the Mennos' win was some clutch defensive work from right fielder Kris Burkholder, who made two running catches including one that prevented a run from scoring in the second inning.

Boadway also made a big play in the fourth inning when the Ravens had runners on first and second base, he worked a pre-arranged pick-off attempt with catcher Dale Boadway. Breaking towards second base on the pitch, Jeff arrived near the base in time to snare a line drive and then double the runner off first base to snuff out a potential Ravens' rally.

The Ravens, who produced just three hits in the game, scored their lone run in the sixth inning and had a great chance to tie or take the lead in that frame when they loaded the bases on three walks. But they had a base runner thrown out at home plate.

Now 5-3 on the season, the Mennos are in Grafton this weekend to take part in an open tournament.

The Mennos resume league play Monday at Newmarket and host Aurora Shoeless Joe's Thursday at 8:30 p.m. in Memorial Park.
