With no relief at the gas pump in the near future and our fuel price hovering around \$1.30 a litre, or are you ready, \$5.92 per gallon, we can only alter our vehicle use minimally. So what we have to do is make our vehicles as efficient as possible. There are many ways of doing this. Most of todays vehicles are computer controlled. That being said, there are sensors directly involved in fuel control. There are more sensors than these, but here are a couple of examples.

The engine coolant temperature sensor senses engine operating temperature. If this sensor becomes defective, the sensor would detect a false reading. If it detected a low reading, the signal sent to the computer would be as if the engine was still not warmed up. This would cause the computer to increase the amount of gas from the injector to the cylinder. An engine thermostat opening too soon will cause the same problem.

Fuel consumption is also regulated by the oxygen sensor in the exhaust system. This senses rich or lean mixtures and is controlled by the computer. It cycles rich to lean depending what the computer needs for vehicle operation. For example, when we accelerate we need a rich mixture. If the sensor cycles slowly, it cannot regulate the fuel programme fast enough therefore wasting gas.



There are many ways we can economise without decreasing our vehicle use. We can analyze your engine to see if you are driving as economically as possible. Most times we can increase your fuel mileage noticably.
