Hachey bowls back to provincials

For a first-time effort, Jane district lawn bowling championships in Newmarket.

In fact, Hachey, a Stouffville resident, and Farthing, who resides in Uxbridge, bowled to the ladies pairs' title and gained entry into the provincial championships in Kingston July 5-6.

Competing against nine teams from Newmarket, Richmond Hill, Uxbridge and Midland, Hachey and Farthing won all five of their games that was capped off with a 21-12 win over a Midland team in Sunday's final.

"It was amazing," said Hachey, who skipped the tandem while Farthing was the lead.

But a sign of things to come took place in their first game when they trailed by four entering the last end before rallying with five to win the game.

In another game, they required extra ends to win.

"Those games might have been an omen for us," Hachey

Hachey attributed their success it to good luck and chemistry.

"Brenda and I have been positive with each other and that helps. During the districts, we saw some dissension with some of the teams and said 'that's good for us," Hachey said. "Brenda and I complement each other well."

Hachey is no stranger to the provincials as she was a participant last year in seniors (threemember teams). Two years ago, she was in the national championships in seniors.

"But it depends who's there to compete," she said. "If we play like we did in Newmarket we can stay in it for awhile."


