The York-Durham Heritage Railway pays tribute to the railroad that helped build this area. It also speaks to the people who put the tourist train on the map.

Area train enthusiasts worked from 1986 to 1996 to see the first run become reality.

You can catch a ride between Stouffville and Uxbridge any Sunday until Oct. 19.

Themed rides include:

- The Teddy Bear Day this Sunday when children and bears ride free with an adult.

- Jazz trains run July 20 and Aug. 17.

- Santa in Summer Aug. 10.

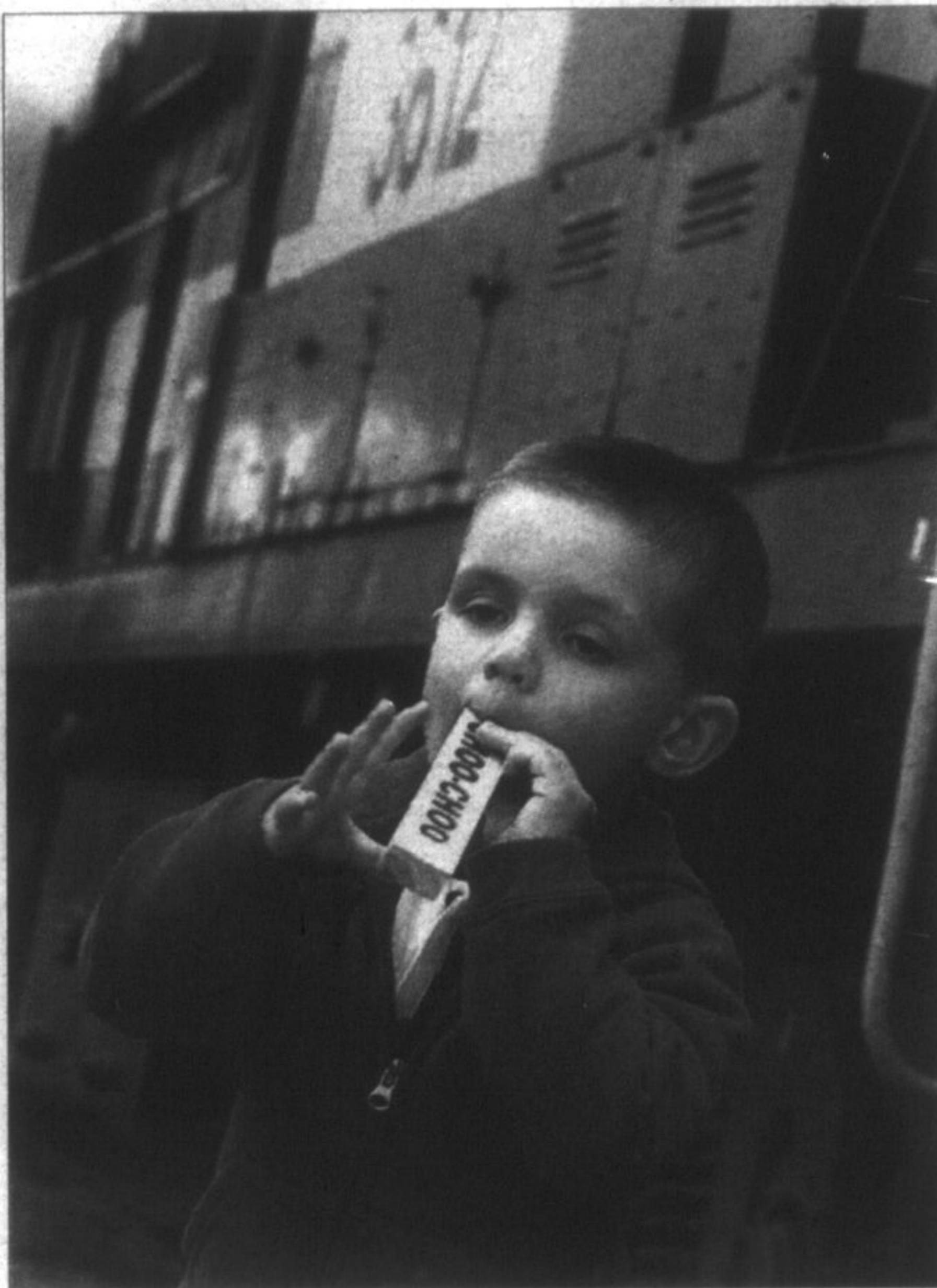
Round-trip tickets are \$22 for adults and \$14 for children.

Saturdays are reserved for special events, including the railway's first Rail-fan day July 26.

The train will stop at scenic spots along the line for photographers to disembark and take action pictures of the train.

Other activities will include a book signing by Rod Clarke, author of *Narrow Gauge through the Bush*, trackwork demonstrations, draws for rides in the engine cab and caboose and lunch.

Admission for the full day is \$50 for adults and \$25 for children under 12.
