"We are excited to get out on the road and honour the accomplishments and legacy of our military heroes," said Jeremy Diamond, the Dominion Institute's managing director.


Veterans Appreciation Day recognizes the sacrifices made by veterans and lets community members show their appreciation outside of Remem-
