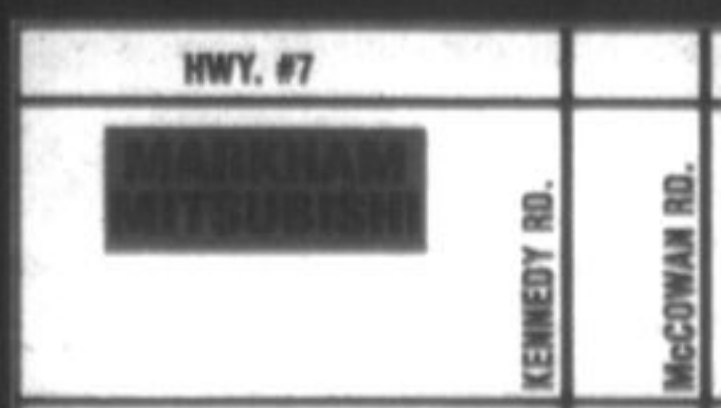

"And we want others to stop by and to bring their kids, too."

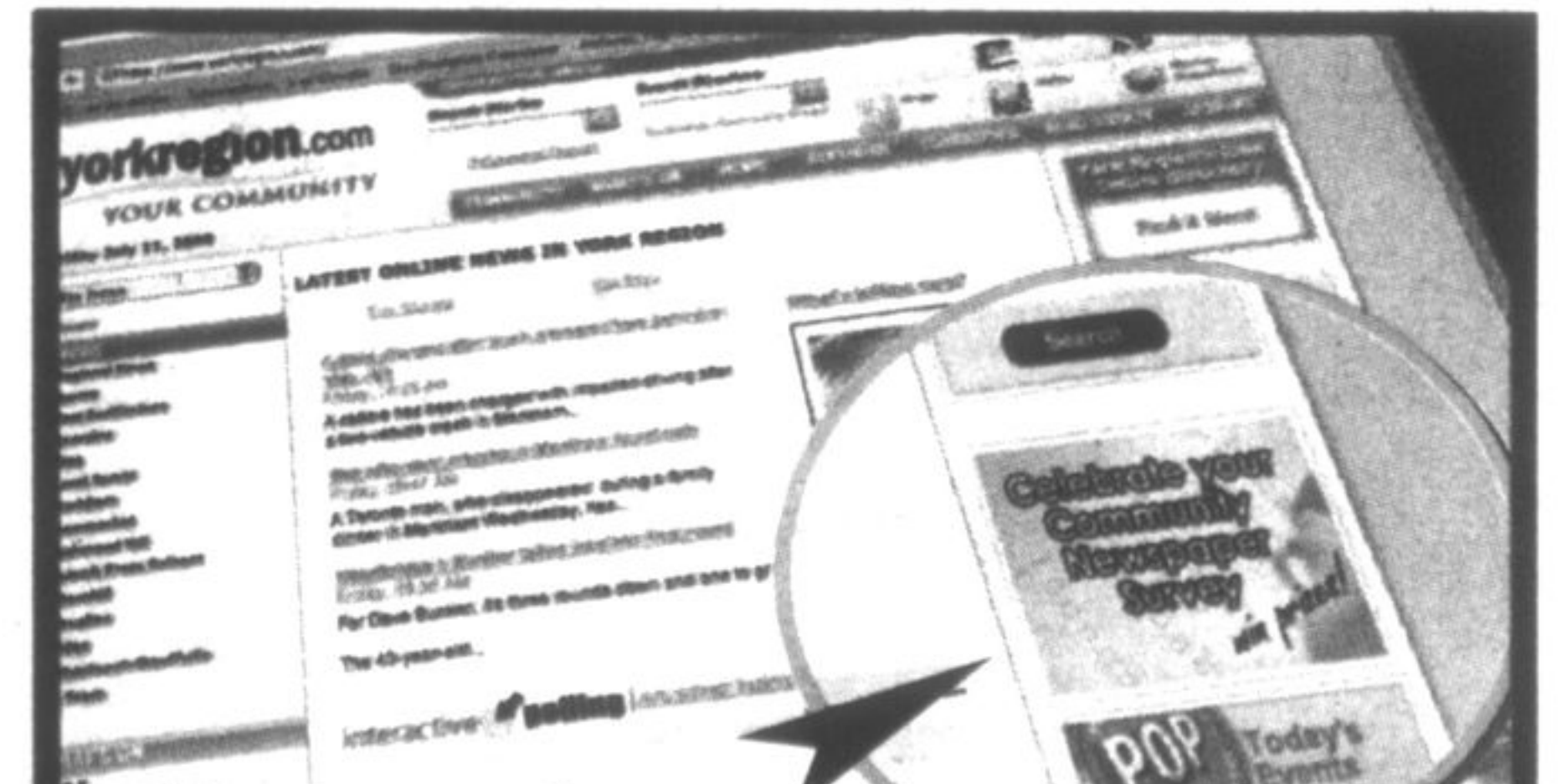
Bill Brown, who owns a garage full of classics, doesn't see any reason the parking lot can't be full.
