Before being turned into a station, GO used the property as a layover yard.


The station is expected to be popular with residents of northern Whitchurch-Stouffville and Uxbridge.

As of Tuesday, September 2, 2008, getting on the GO will be even easier with the opening of our Lincolnville GO Station. Located on Bethesda Sideroad at 10th Line, the new station will be accessible and have parking for over 150 cars.

Lincolnville GO Station is on our Stouffville train line, which also serves the Stouffville, Mount Joy, Markham, Centennial, Unionville, Milliken, Agincourt, and Kennedy GO Stations, and Toronto's Union Station. Morning southbound train times for these stations remain the same but there will be minor adjustments to some arrivals at Union. There will also be changes to some northbound trips, so be sure to check the new schedule.

GO Trains are parked at Lincolnville overnight, so generally it will be the train parked closest to the parking lot that will be the next to depart in the mornings. Single-ride tickets and day passes may be purchased at ticket vending machines at the new station. Other types of tickets and passes are available at Stouffville GO Station, GO ticket agencies, Union Station, and most other GO stations.

Uxbridge buses that currently connect to train service southbound at Stouffville and northbound at Mount Joy will be discontinued, and buses will make the connection at Lincolnville instead. Although, the schedule will no longer show Dickson's Hill and Markville Mall, buses will continue to serve both locations. Buses will start to use the new loop at Lincolnville GO Station as of Saturday, August 30, 2008.
