

SDSS rugby boys reach Markham tourney semifinals

The Stouffville District Secondary School Spartans senior boys' rugby team advanced to the semifinals of the Rugby Ontario Seven's high school tournament before falling to Barrie Central Collegiate 24-5 at Fletcher's Field in Markham Tuesday.

Jesse Lofthouse scored the lone try for the Spartans, who trailed 14-5 at the half.

The Spartans advanced to the semifinals after defeating Leaside Collegiate 40-0, Bradford Collegiate 17-0 and Sir Oliver Mowat (Scarborough) 25-20.

Facing Rick Hansen Secondary School (Mississauga) in the quarter-finals, the Spartans prevailed 39-5.

The Spartans bantams captured the consolation final of the Rugby Ontario tournament with a 15-12 victory over Don Mills Collegiate Wednesday at Fletcher's Field.

Mario Farisco had all three SDSS tries.

The Spartans began the day by winning their preliminary-round matches over Don Mills Collegiate 15-5, Sacred Heart (Newmarket) 24-5 and Leaside Collegiate 29-5.

In the semifinals, the Spartans fell 15-14 to Dr. J.M. Dennison (Newmarket).
