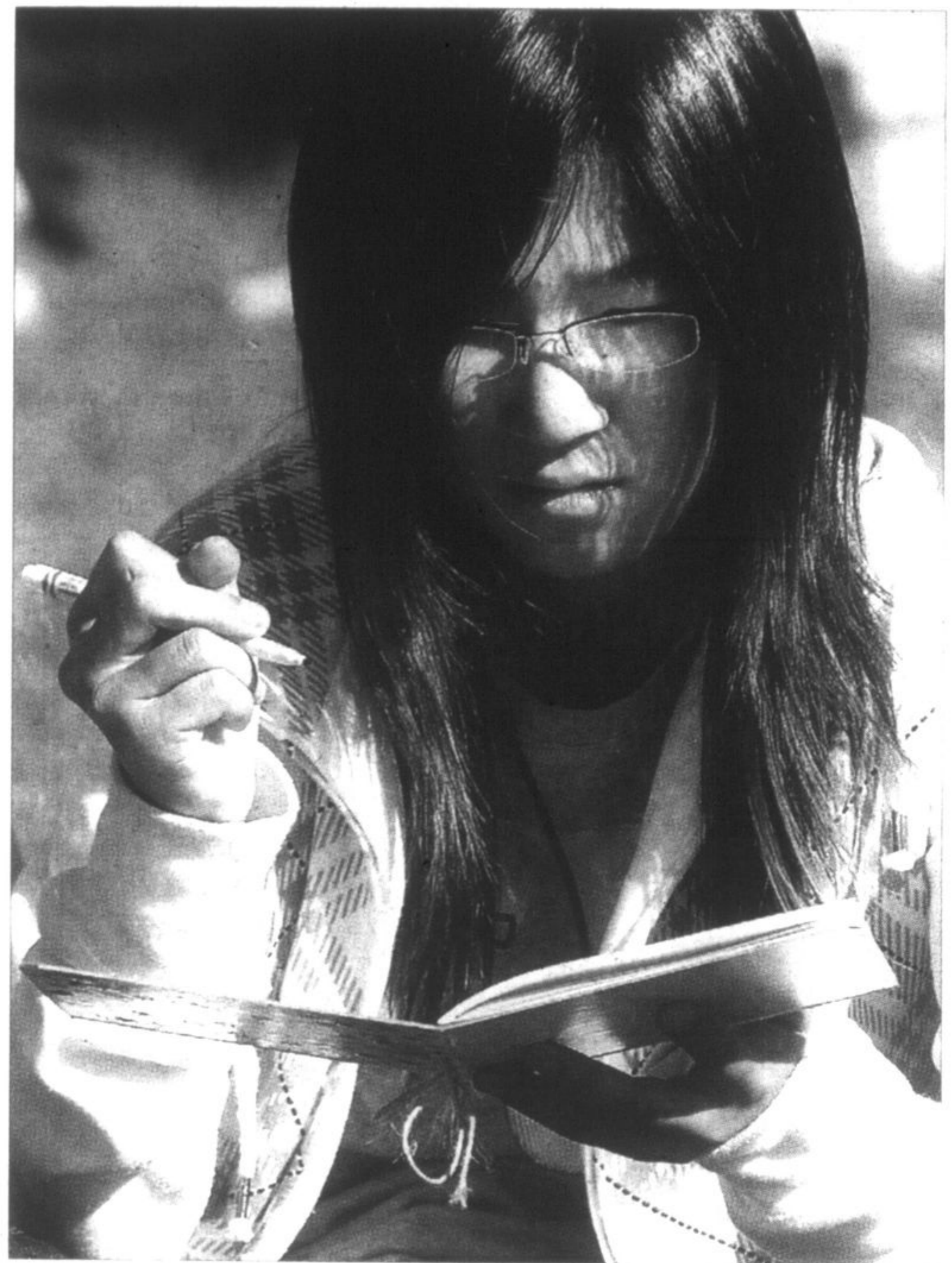


Becoming green leaders
