in addition to the opportunity to trick or treat in a safe environment in our miniature village," said village co-ordinator Karen Richards.

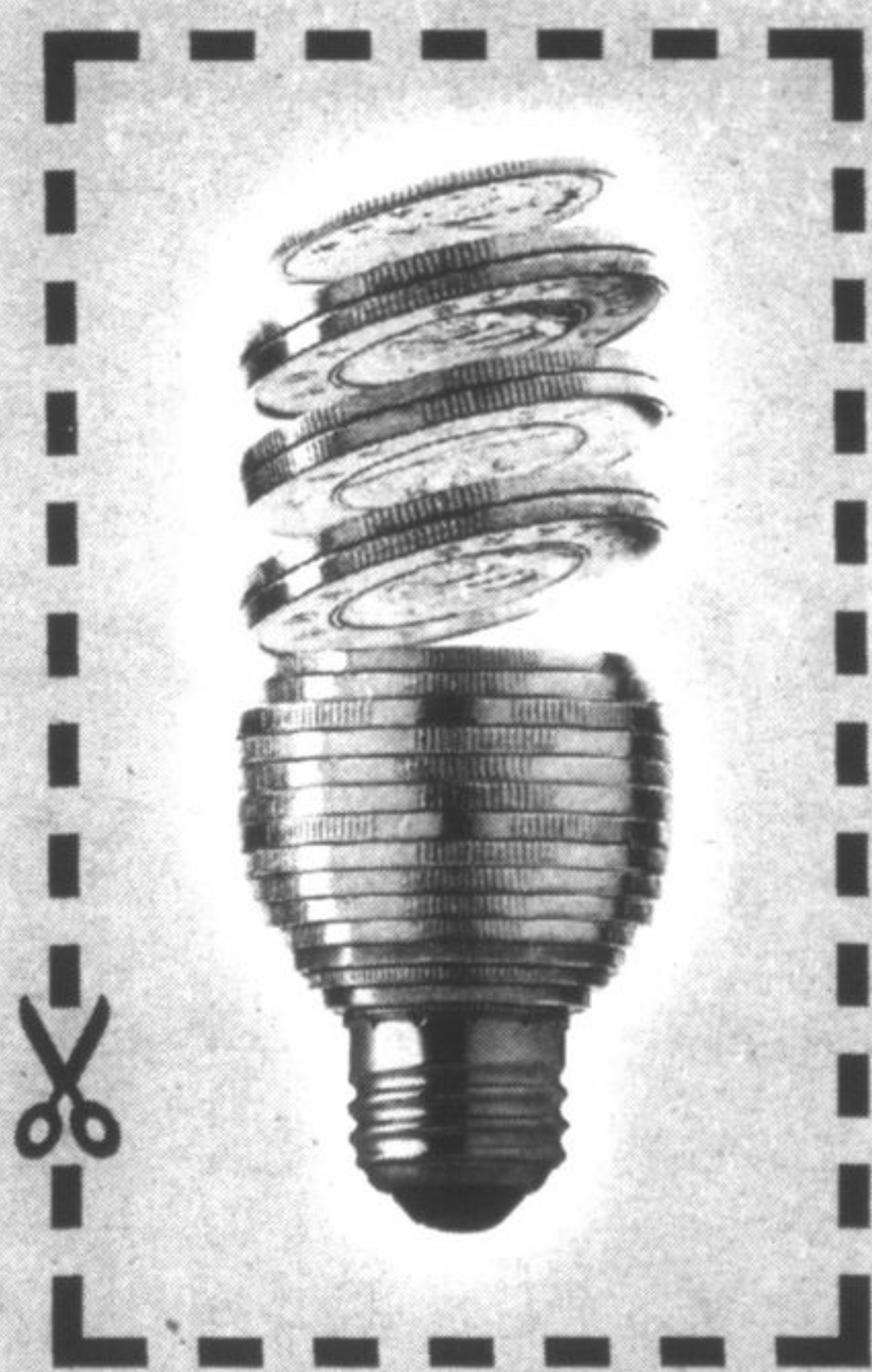
Children and their parents are encouraged to attend in costume. Members of York Regional Police will pass along Halloween safety tips to trick-or-treaters.

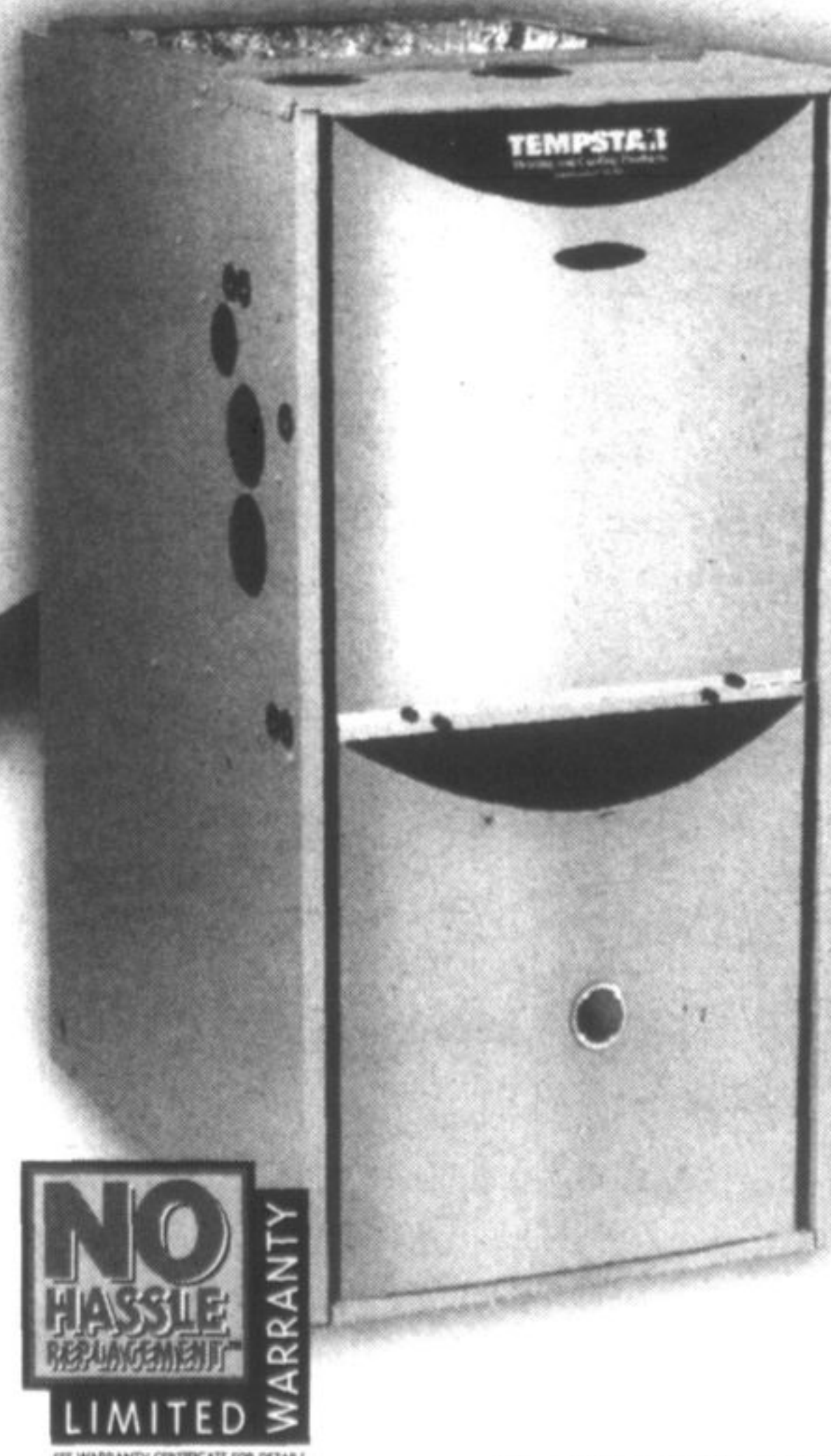
