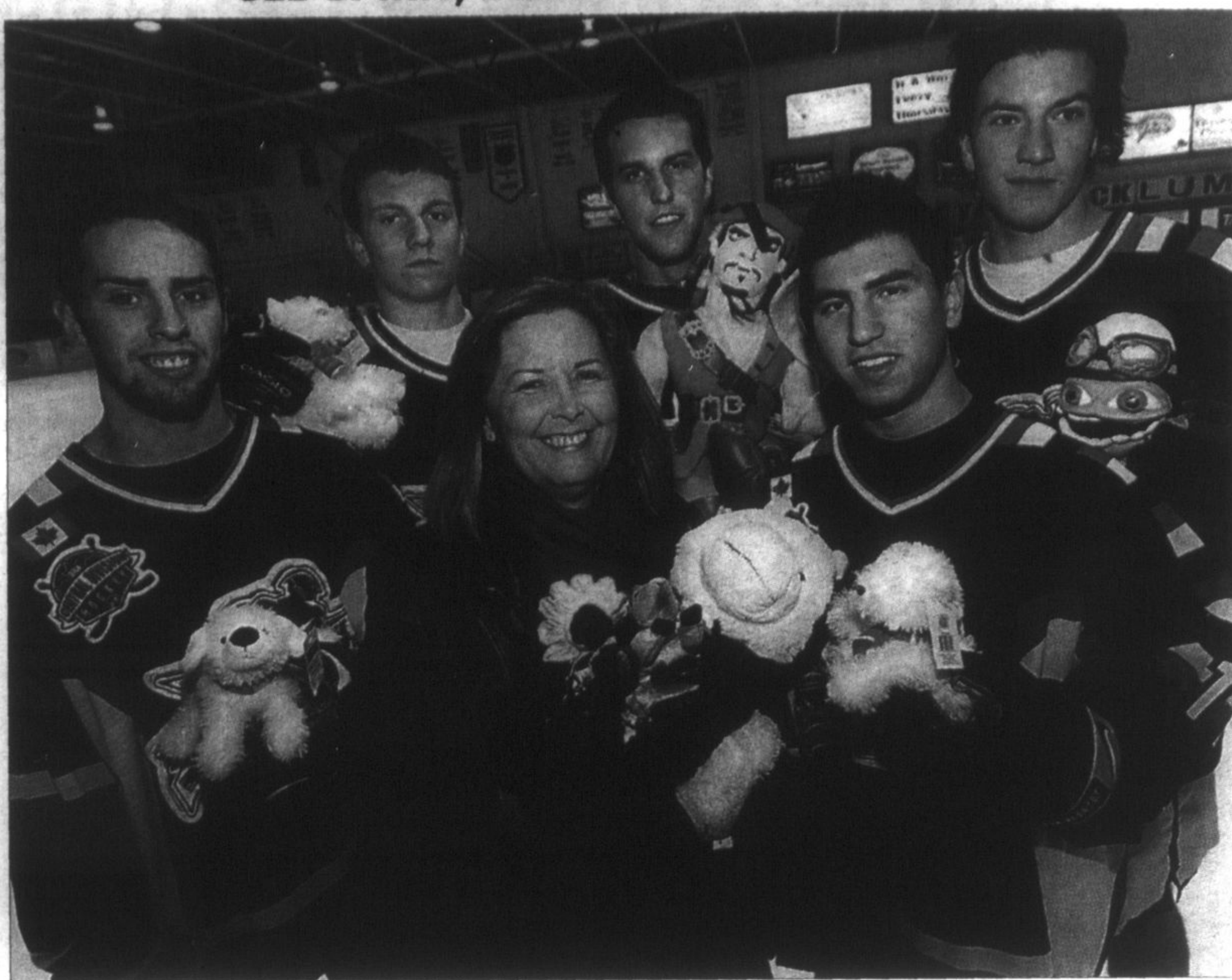

## SEE SPIRIT, BEARS ON ICE THURSDAY

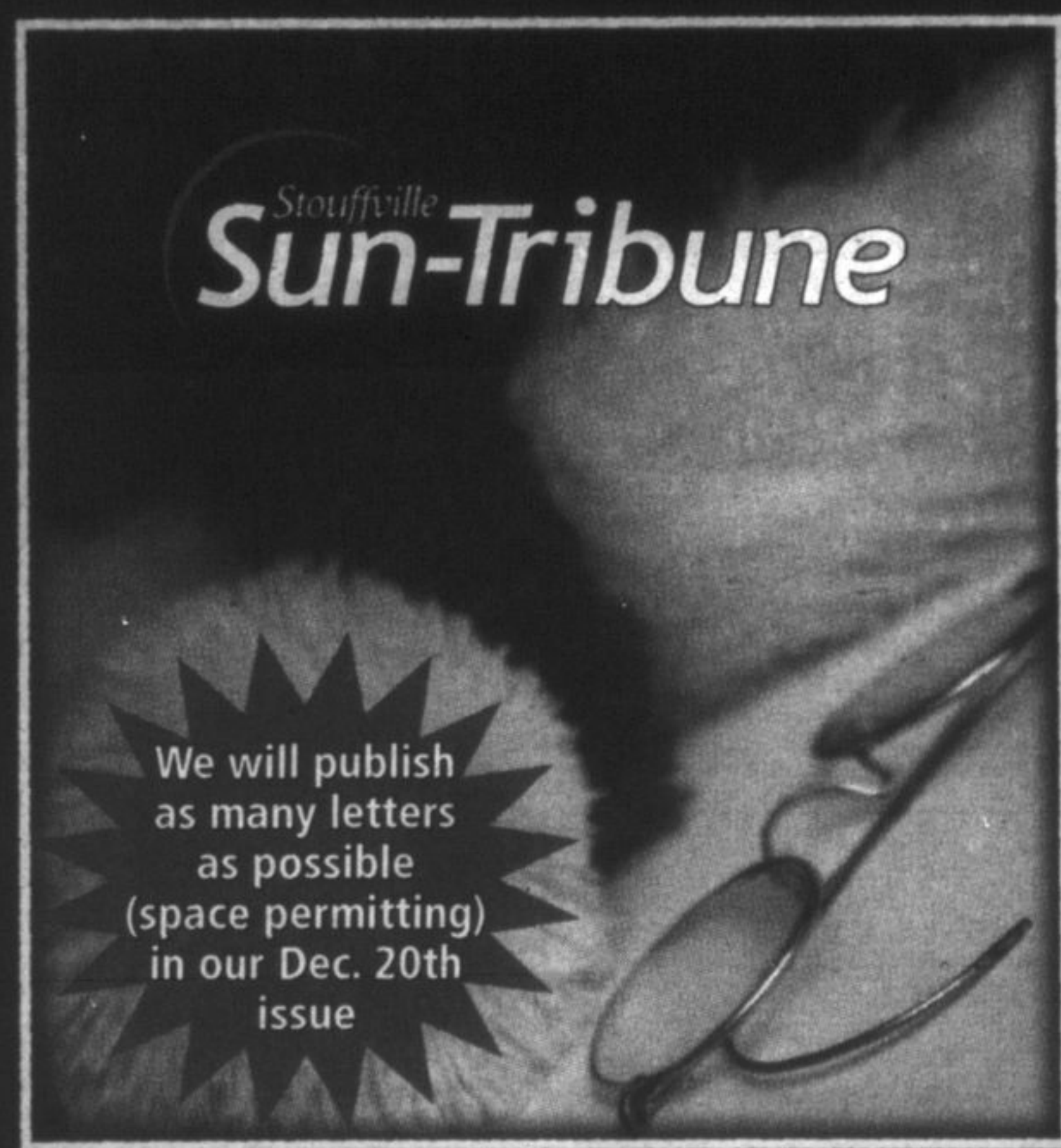
