ACCESS TO About MyProperty™

now available at the Whitchurch-Stouffville Public Library

The municipality of Whitchurch-Stouffville, the Whitchurch-Stouffville Public Library and the Municipal Property Assessment Corporation (MPAC), are working together to offer access to AboutMyProperty™ on the computer terminals at the library. This service is being made available for those property owners who do not have Internet access at home.

AboutMyProperty™ is a secure, online service available on MPAC's website at www.mpac.ca.

Through AboutMyProperty™, residential property owners can access:

- √ detailed information about their own property;
- √ information on up to 24 additional residential properties of their choice.

This information can be used to compare an assessment to similar properties in the area and help determine if the assessment is accurate. Property owners may also choose to file a Request for Reconsideration through AboutMyProperty™. Property owners will need their AboutMyProperty™ User ID and Password to login. This information can be found on the bottom right hand corner of the 2008 Property Assessment Notice.
