Hit-and-run took life of Stouffville girl in '73

York Region Crime Stoppers needs your help identifying a suspect in connection with an old case in Whitchurch-Stouffville.

It occurred more than 36 years ago.

On Feb. 6, 1973, there was a hit-and-run incident in Stouffville in which a 10-year-old girl was killed.

After 7 p.m., Sheryl Blundell and her friend were walking east along Main Street, near the Ninth Line, when a motorist stopped to ask the girls for directions.

When the girls approached the car, a westbound vehicle struck the girls.

The driver slowed then sped up and left

the area.

Sheryl died in hospital while her friend suffered serious injuries.

The only description of the vehicle was that it was a 1960s full size Ford that was either red or grey or a combination of both.

The incident was re-enacted for a Crime Stoppers TV news item, but remains unsolved.
