Bluegrass musician hosts 5th annual concert March 28

Tom McCreight loves his bluegrass.

He's been hooked since 1970.

The Stouffville native has his own five-piece band, Silverbirch, produces bluegrass CDs and writes about the musical style for area publications.

The retired teacher and school administrator has organized the annual Silverbirch Charity Concert in Uxbridge since 2005.

Guitarist Wendell Ferguson headlines this year's show March 28 at 7:30 p.m. at the Uxbridge Music Hall.

Proceeds this year and last go to ArtsCan Circle, a registered charity that links performing artists with Aboriginal youth at risk in Canada's north.

Earlier shows benefited the Steven Lewis Foundation, cancer research and the Uxbridge Youth

Centre.

A resident of Udora, his band has played concerts, fairs and festivals throughout Ontario.

Silverbirch hosts a monthly stage jam at the Good Time Cafe in Newmarket on the second Wednesday of the month.

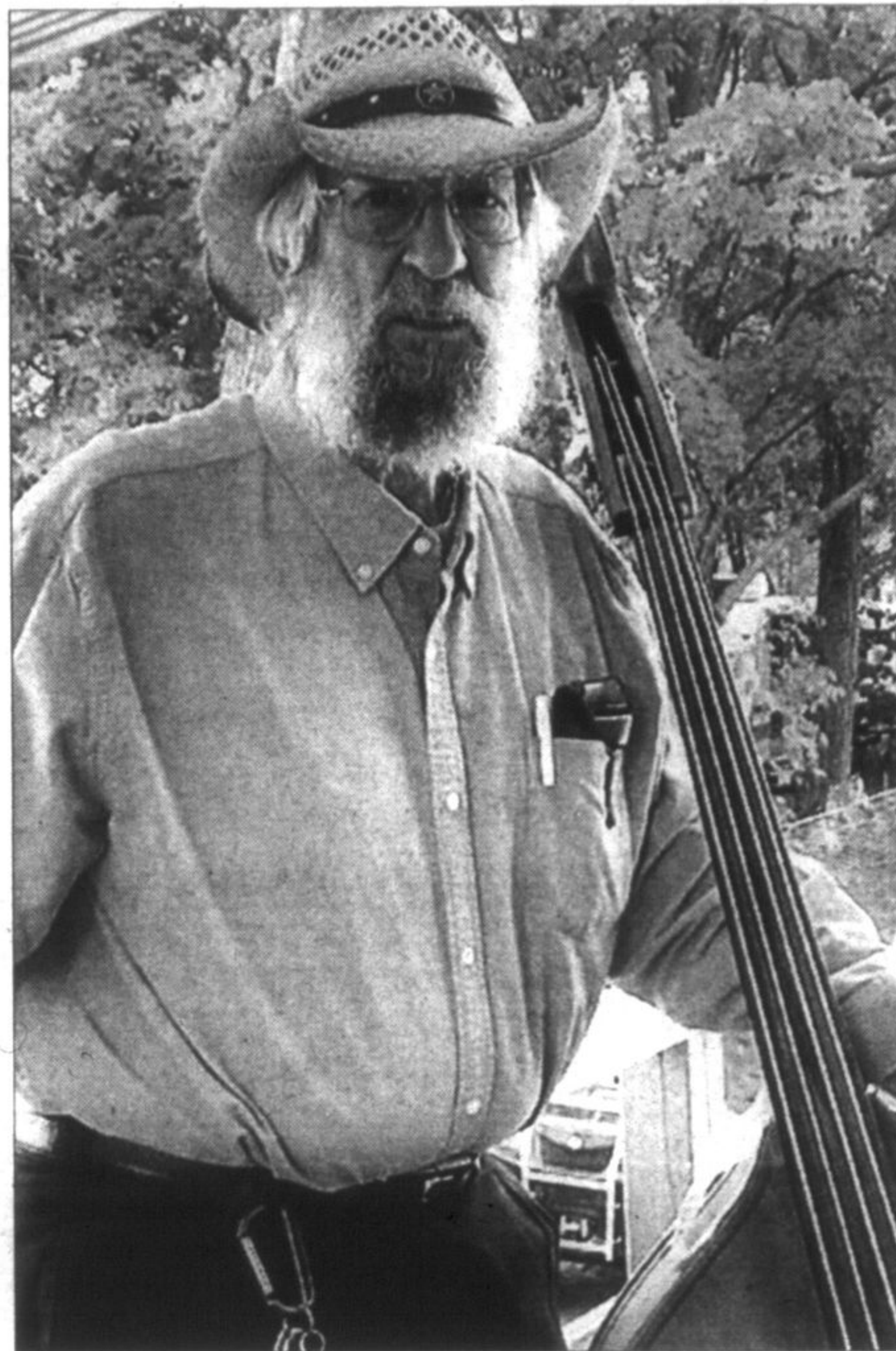
Mr. McCreight ran a home-based business selling bluegrass CDs and books until 2006.
