Scheduled to begin play in the York Region Athletic Association's North Divi-

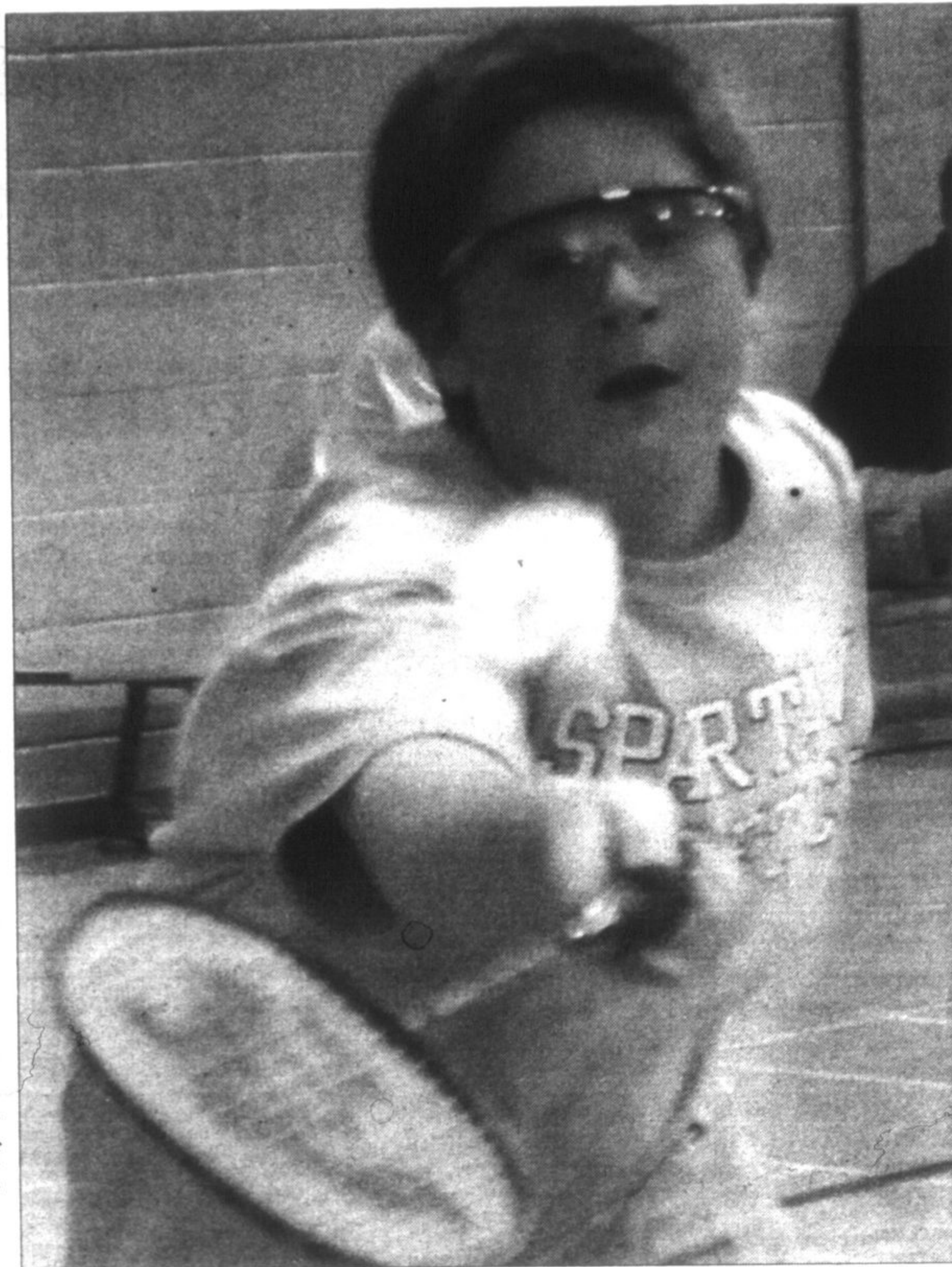
sion the week of May 4, the Spartans will have their next outdoor tune-up May 2 when they travel to Alliston to participate in the Banting Collegiate Tournament.
