

## 19 on Park ready for opening night

The highly anticipated Lebovic Centre for Arts and Entertainment - Nineteen on the Park, will finally be unveiled to the public this Saturday night.

There are also many free events occurring throughout the two-week celebration that

include Spring Spirit, which is an ecumenical worship service Sunday at 9:30 a.m., followed by an afternoon of Mother and Mother Earth celebrations, and Sustainable Stouffville, where students will mount artistic responses to films created by youth for youth on sustainability.

Other events include Stouffville Night at the Movies, Open Mic night, Young Art and a Youth Cafe.
