Carrick on NHL draft radar

The 2010 National Hockey League entry draft won't happen until next June.

But Sam Carrick's name is already on the radar.

In the NHL Central Scouting's early listings, the 17-year-old Stouffville resident was among several Ontario Hockey League prospects who were identified as potential selections for the 2010 lottery.

Completing his rookie season with the Brampton Battalion this past year, the five-foot, 11-inch, 174-pound forward compiled 10 goals and 11 assists in 61 regular season tilts. In 21 postseason games, he had one goal.

Carrick is the younger brother

of Jake Carrick, a forward with the Sault Ste. Marie Greyhounds.

Tanaka to play at St. Mary's

Cory Tanaka will be in Halifax, N.S., this winter as a member of the St. Mary's University Huskies.

The 21-year-old Stouffville resident concluded his Ontario Hockey League career this past season with the Belleville Bulls. He was an integral part of the club that won three consecutive East Division titles.

Launching his five-year OHL career with the Plymouth Whalers in 2004-05 and playing part of the following season with them before being dealt to the Bulls,

Tanaka finished this past season by becoming the league's all-time leader in career regular season games played.

In 67 games last season, Tanaka scored 17 goals while adding 33 assists and accumulating 44 penalty minutes. He added one goal and nine assists in 17 playoff games.

Tanaka recorded 43 goals and 102 assists in 249 career regular season games with the Bulls. Tanaka also added 14 goals and 23 assists in a franchise record 59 career playoff games with Belleville.

"He knows how to play the game. We don't have to reinvent the wheel," Huskies head coach Trevor Stienburg said.
