Ms Crochetiere rose to fame as a member of the Canadian pop vocal group Sugar Jones in 2002. Following the group's demise a year later, Ms Crochetiere released

her first solo EP - Cafe. In 2007, she followed it up with a full-length CD entitled *A Better Place*.

Earlier this year, Ms Crochetiere was nominated for best female vocalist at the Canadian Smooth

Jazz awards.

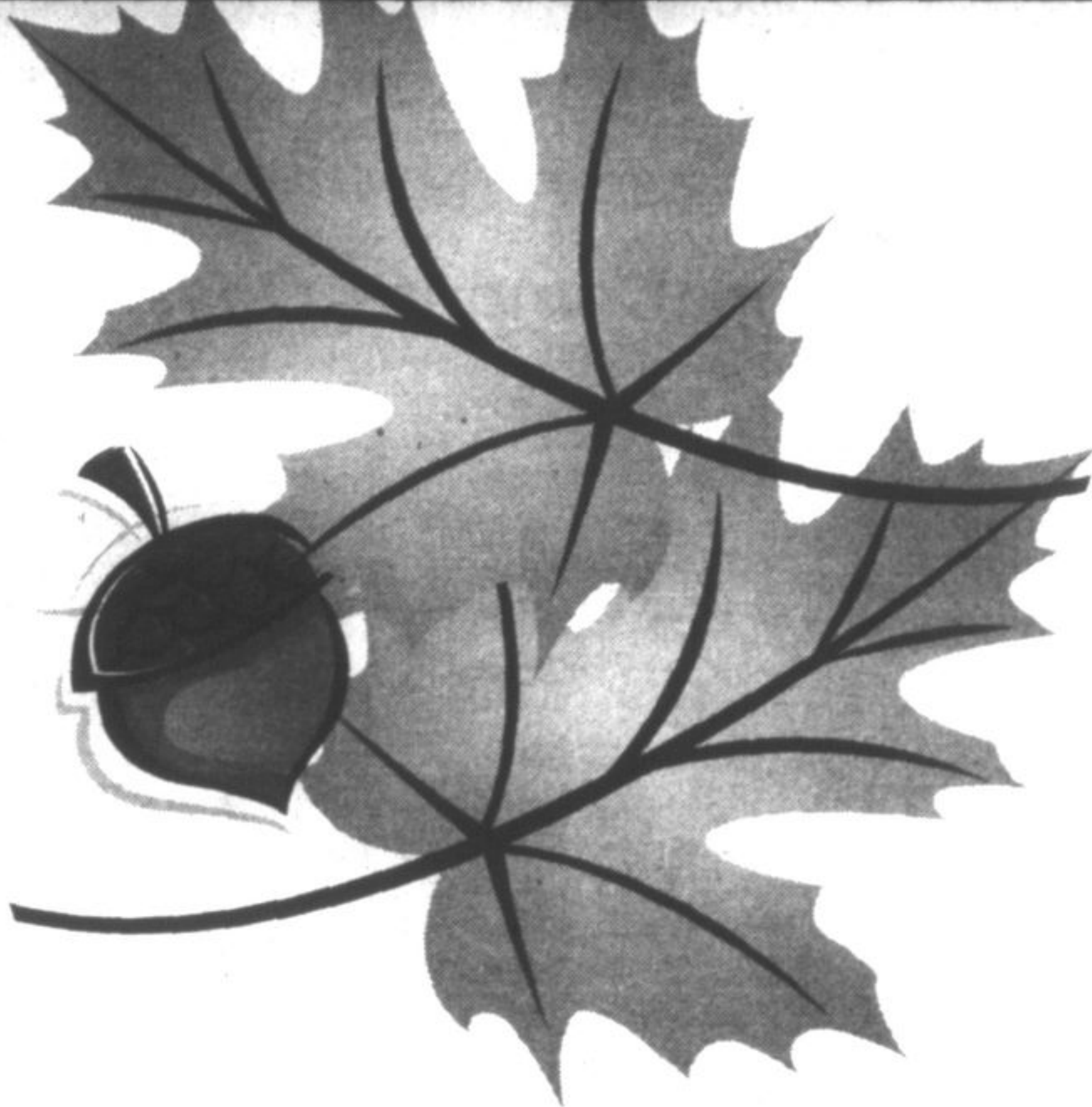
