Candidates may file a nomination form during regular business hours commencing January 4th, 2010 with the last time for filing being 2:00 p.m. on September 10th, 2010. A prescribed fee, which may be refundable, in the amount of \$200.00 for Mayoral candidates and \$100.00 for all other candidates payable by cash, certified cheque or money order, must accompany the nomination form. In addition, Candidates will be required to provide a \$230 deposit pursuant to the Town's sign by-law.

Candidates must not spend or raise funds for their election campaign until their nomination form is filed.

Please have trees curbside by 7:00 a.m.

NOTE: Collection crews will not dig out a tree or climb a snow bank to retrieve a tree.



REMOVAL OF SNOW & ICE FROM SIDEWALKS

The Town is requesting your cooperation in clearing away snow and ice from sidewalks abutting your property. Town regulations provide that snow and ice be removed from sidewalks within 12 hours after a snowfall.

If you are disabled or over 65 years of age and physically unable to shovel snow and have **no other able bodied persons living in the home**, please contact Public Works at 905-640-1910 or 905-895-5299 ext. 306.

MUNICIPAL ENCROACHMENTS

The Public Works Department reminds residents that the Town is **not** responsible for any damage caused during our winter maintenance operations to items such as fences, posts, interlocking brick work, concrete and wood curbs that have been placed on Town property.

Removal of these items would aid with the road and sidewalk plowing operations and prevent damage to these property improvements. The Town, at its discretion, may request the removal of these obstructions.

**GARBAGE COLLECTION CHANGES

Residents are advised of the change to the garbage collection week starting the week of January 18th, 2010. There will be two (2) garbage collection weeks in a row and bi-weekly collection will commence the week of February 1st, 2010.

All changes are outlined in the new collection calendar. Please keep your new schedule in a convenient location and refer to it weekly to avoid any confusion and/or missed collections.

Blue Box and Green Bin weekly collections are not impacted by this garbage collection week adjustment.

This collection week adjustment will enable the contractor to improve efficiencies and response time when support vehicles are required on heavy collection days.
