## 407 rates going up

Starting Feb. 1, Hwy. 407 users will have to pay more to save time.

The ETR announced toll increases on certain segments of the highway.

Peak-hour tolls for light vehicles between the QEW and Hwy. 410, Hwy. 427 and Hwy. 400, and Markham and Brock roads will be 21.35 cents as opposed to 19.85 cents

per km.

Peak-hour tolls for light vehicles travelling between Hwy. 410 and Hwy. 427 and Hwy. 400 and Markham Road will be 20.10 cents as opposed to 19.25 cents per km.

The 407 ETR plans to invest more than \$70 million in 2010 to build 20 kms of new lanes and other highway improvements to help reduce congestion.

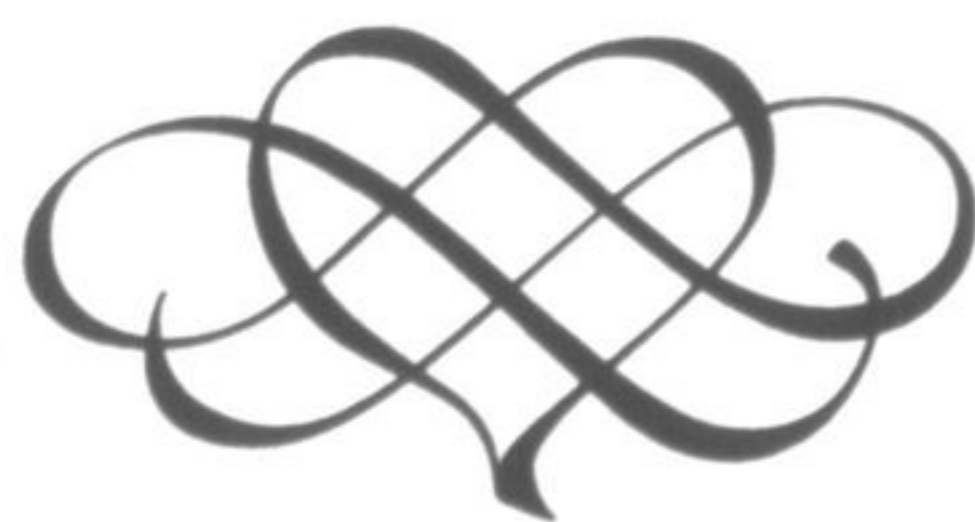
