

HOCKEY: Stouffville native has never played in minors

Placed on waivers by Wings, May weighs future in Mexico

Brad May's professional hockey career might have reached a crossroad when the Detroit Red Wings placed him on waivers just prior to the National Hockey League's Olympic break.

Signed by the Red Wings this season as a free agent on Oct. 7, the 38-year-old Stouffville native played in 40 games and had one assist.

Efforts to contact May were unsuccessful. However, a voice message on his telephone revealed he was taking some time off during the NHL break to vacation in Mexico.

Known for bringing a physical presence onto the ice, the veteran forward's professional career has spanned over 18 seasons that began with the Buffalo Sabres during the 1991-92 season.

During his NHL career in which he played in 1,041 regular season games, May was a member of the Anaheim Ducks' Stanley Cup-winning team in the 2007-08 campaign.

May, who has never played a game in the minors, is being eyed by Detroit's farm team in Grand Rapids, Mich.

During the series, the Clippers received excellent goaltending from the tandem of Jordan Ogden and Ethan Volpe, who between them only allowed three goals in three games for a 1.00 goals against average.
