## Geranium Homes going green

Geranium Homes' Cardinal Point Phase IV South will be the first neighbourhood in Whitchurch-Stouffville built to ENERGY STAR® for New Homes levels. The development is in northwestern Stouffville.

New homes built under the program are approximately 25 per cent more energy efficient than those built to minimum provincial building codes. It means reduced energy costs for homeowners.

"Geranium Green," the company's own construction program, uses sustainable techniques, materials and building practices. Value-added energy-saving features include raised heel trusses (creating a more attractive

elevation and allowing for better insulation), clay brick and upgraded exterior cladding, ENERGY STAR® windows, a high-efficiency furnace, sprayed-in foam insulation and 40-year roof shingles.

Bungalows range from 1,619 to 2,442 square feet, with prices starting in the mid-\$400,000s to just over \$500,000.

Freehold townhomes are 1,233 to 2,042 square feet and start in the low \$300,000s. First move-in dates will be next winter.

Geranium has built more than 6,000 homes in Ontario during the last 30 years.
