Stouffville's arenas have turned into outposts of art.

Recycling, hockey and art have all come together for the Hockey Town exhibition, which continues until April 3 at the rinks and the Latham Gallery.

At the Stouffville Arena, you'll see two landscapes created by artist Liz Pead, fashioned out of used hockey equipment.

In the Stouffville Clippers Sports Complex, a huge eye-catching tree-like structure made of used hockey sticks, also by Ms Pead, overlooks the ice.

The gallery exhibit includes a re-creation of a "rec" room, with a TV set playing Wayne Gretzky's farewell speech spoken by artist Leah Modigliani.

More hockey equipment landscapes by Ms Pead, are at the gallery, along with small, remote-control creations on wheels she has made for kids and adults to operate.

Colourful slapshots fired by the steady hand of Liss Platt turn into delicate works of art.

The show has travelled from the MacLaren Art Centre in Barrie and will continue on to Manitoba after its stay in Stouffville.

Gallery hours are 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesdays to Saturdays.

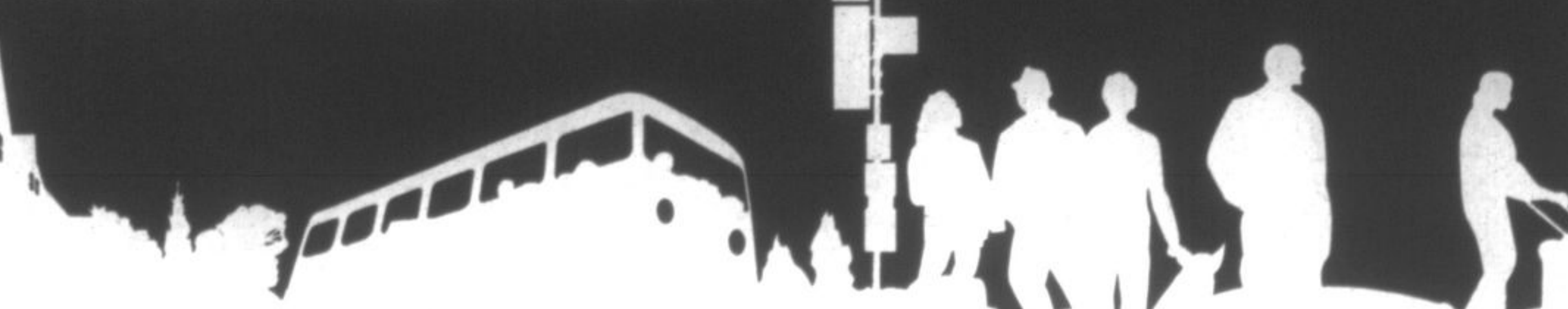
