Plans are already under way for next year's Professional Series, which will include a Joni Mitchell tribute, the female folk duo Madison Violet as well as dance troupes Motus O and Soulful Messiah during the Christmas holiday season.

"We're actually drawing in from other communities and whenever that's possible, that's a great thing," Mr. Foster said.

Performing this Sunday is classical music's the Aldeburgh Connection. The show starts at 2 p.m. and tickets are \$13 with promo code ACDS10.


