Fighter ready for added exposure

Sean Pierson is getting what he feels is his big break in the world of mixed martial arts.

The 24-year-old Stouffville resident was recently selected and signed to compete in the upcoming Bellator Season 2 Tournament.

While the series isn't the UFC, it will be conducted over 12 consecutive weeks and receive media exposure in most U.S. households due to what Pierson described as one of the largest television distribution alliances in mixed martial arts history.

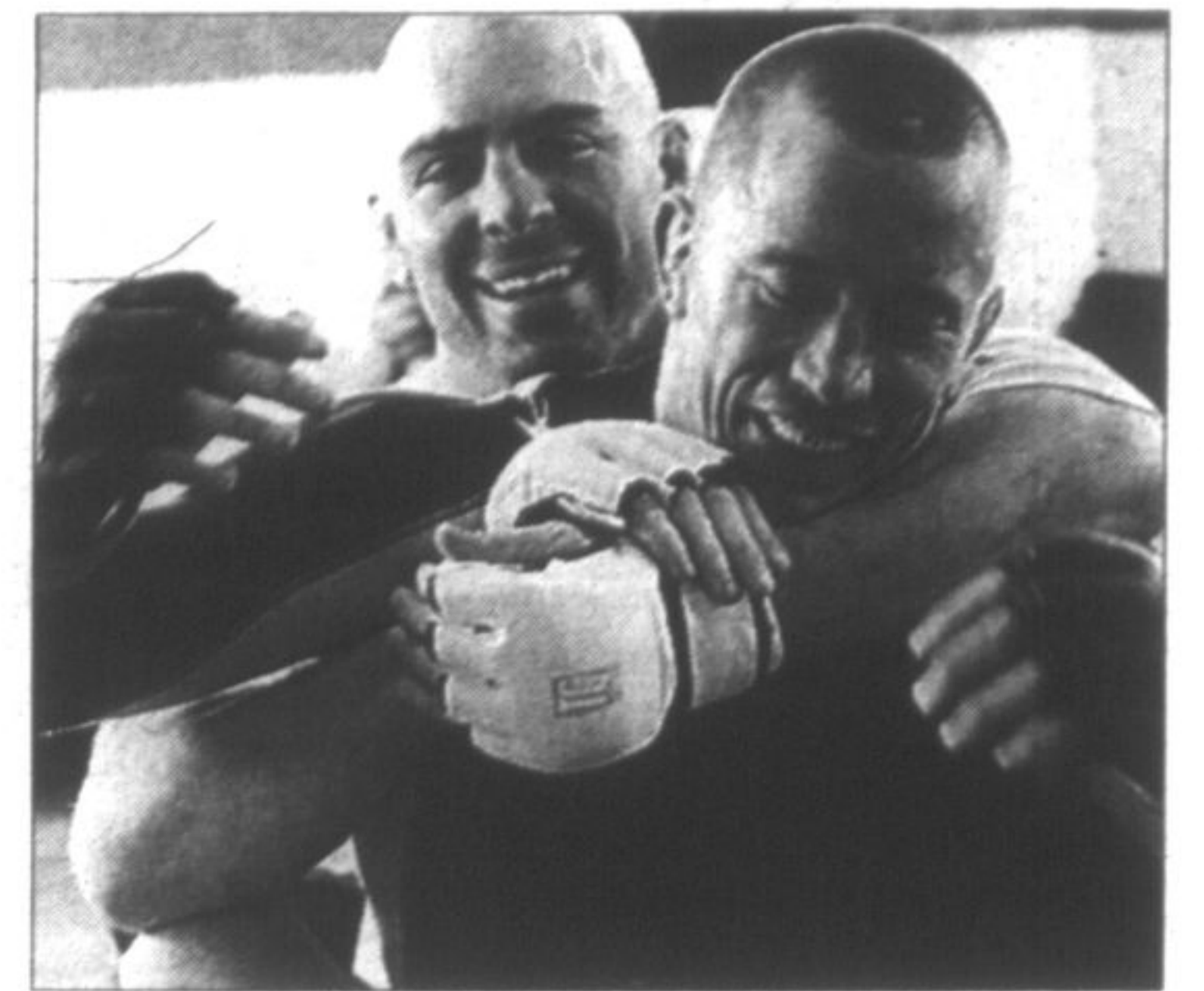
Each Bellator event will be distributed live in prime time Thursday nights on FOX Sports Net and its regional sports network affiliates. The top moments from each week's live events will then be condensed into a 30-minute highlight show, broadcast every Saturday night, late night, on NBC. A one-hour highlight show will air in Spanish on Telemundo every Saturday night from midnight to 1 a.m. In Canada, The Score has been signed on to distribute the shows.

Competing in the welterweight division, Pierson's first round match is scheduled to take place April 22 at the Mohegan Sun Casino in Connecticut.

Pierson will face the top seed in the tournament, Dan Hornbuckle, the 16th-ranked fighter in the world. His record is 19-2.

The Stouffville fighter is red hot. "I've won my last four fights, all by first-round KOS or TKO's," he said. "This has helped me develop a strong following in the Canadian scene."

"Bellator was looking for top international fighters and most of the Canadian organizations were suggesting me as a representative."

I think Bellator was also looking for well-spoken athletes who represent the sport well.

"I really appreciated the fact that my colleagues think highly of me in this manner as I try to represent myself in the best possible manner and hope to be a role model where I can."

Currently training with UFC welterweight champion Georges St-Pierre and his Tristar team in Montreal, Pierson noted the winner of the tournament will receive \$100,000 as well as TV exposure across the U.S., Mexico and Canada.

At that point he noted the winner will get an opportunity to fight for the title against Bellator's current champion and it would catapult the winner into the top 20 welterweights in the world.

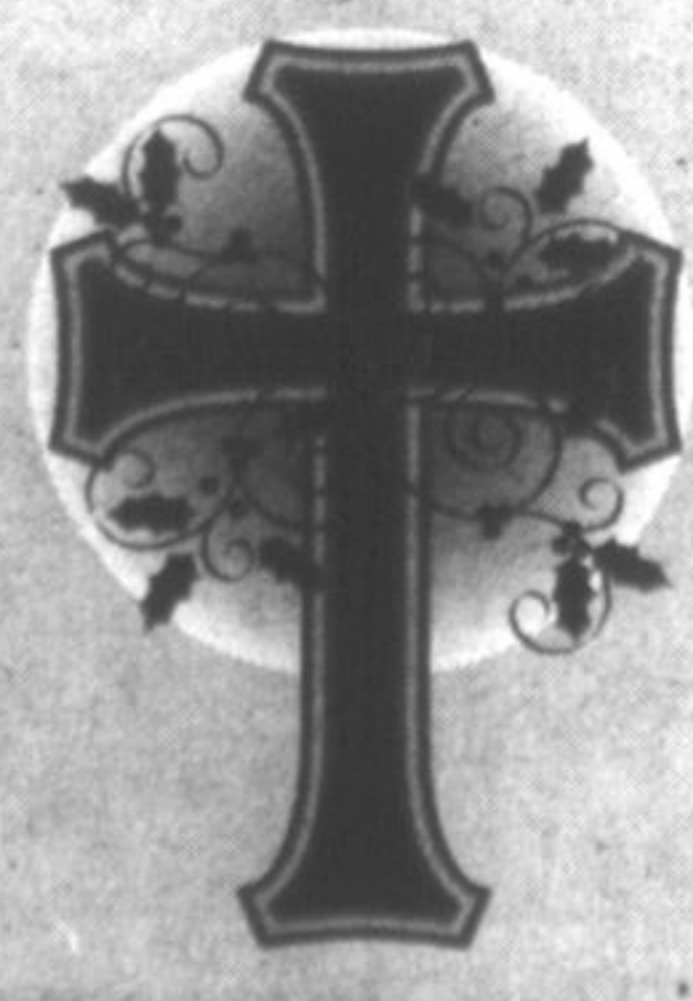
