same way other communities such as Markham and Vaughan have done — the town provides the land and potentially fencing and a group of volunteers runs the park. "It really wouldn't take that much. It's just where to put it," Mr. OSullivan said.

A group of residents first lobbied council for an off-leash dog park about 10 years ago. The idea was negated.

However, a staff report on the viability of a local off-leash park will be presented to council in May or June.
