



SPORTS: Stouffville Secondary Spartans

Track team launched today

When the Stouffville District Secondary School Spartans track and field team makes its debut at the York Region Athletic Association indoor championships at York University today, Steve Jimmo hopes his contingent will make its presence felt.

They don't have to finish first, second or third, the Spartans head coach said.

SENIORS LEAD WAY

What remains imperative though, is that each entrant exhibits a degree of progression before they embark on the outdoor campaign, which is slated to begin with the Rowland Games at York University April 24 followed by the Cardinal Carter Invitational at York University May 1 and 2.

Fielding an enthusiastic group of 40 students – up from last year's number – Jimmo describes this year's team as one with pockets of strength. Leading that group, he said, is the senior boys team.

"We've got a lot of strong runners and a few jumpers and throwers," he said.

Among those who Jimmo has high hopes for are Michael Bourgeois, a Grade 11 student who specializes in long distance events including the steeplechase.

While Bourgeois' strength is in longer distances, Jimmo revealed he will run in shorter events at today's indoor championships including the 400m and 800m as a means of building up for his stronger events once the outdoor season begins.

Other members anchoring the senior boys'

team are Jon Wiseman in the 400m and 800m, Evan Malcolm high jump and Chris Daniels long jump and sprint races.

All are in Grade 11.

With a couple of strong runners on their senior girls' team, Jimmo feels Demi Chalkias will be among the leaders.

A Grade 11 student, Chalkias' forte is in longer distance events.

"She's really been training hard since we began workouts," Jimmo said.

In the junior division, Jimmo said their girls' team has strong numbers.

Leading that group is Olivia Bolender.

Specializing in horizontal jumping events, the Grade 10 student qualified for last year's Ontario Federation of School Athletic Associations championships and placed fifth in the midget girls' triple jump.

Where the Spartans will have a big void is in the midget division where they will only field a girls' entry this year.

FEW YOUNGSTERS

With midget competitors being first-year Grade 9 students, Jimmo said it's still a little early to see what their niche might be.

But upon conclusion of the indoor meet, he hopes to have a better handle on what events each might excel in as they lead up to this year's YRAA outdoor championships.

While hoping his individual competitors can establish some school records at the indoor championships, Jimmo would also like to see his seven relay teams (two senior boys, two senior girls, two junior girls and one midget girls) do well in the 4 x 200m events.
