### Geocache, build birdhouse during Earth Day at reservoir today

It was 40 years ago the first Earth Day took place in the United States.

Since then, Earth Day has become the most celebrated environmental event worldwide with more than six million Canadians joining one billion people in more than 170 countries in staging environmental awareness events, according to Micole Ongman, manager of recreation for the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville.

Locally, a variety of activities will take place today at the Stouffville Reservoir from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. The reservoir is on Millard Street, just east of Ninth Line.

Geocaching demonstrations will take place at 10:30 and 11:30 a.m.

"This introductory program will teach par-

ticipants how to use available co-ordinates to seek out 'caches' that have been placed along the trails by geocaching enthusiasts," according to Ms Ongman.

There will also be an opportunity to try out pole walking, as well as build a birdhouse and plant a mini three sisters garden to take home.

Africycle will be holding its Great Bike Roundup at the reservoir, in which residents are encouraged to drop off their old bikes to be refurbished and sent to Africa for use.

Free top soil will be available at the Stouffville Clippers Sports Complex. Just bring a shovel and container.

The neighbourhood cleanup challenge is also underway. Just register your event and bags and gloves will be supplied. Garbage pickup will be arranged after the event. All registrations will be submitted into a draw for a free pool party.
