## Spirit staying in Stouffville: Owner

When the board of governors representing teams from the Central Canadian Hockey League and Ontario Junior A Hockey League gather in Toronto this weekend to conduct meetings, change is anticipated.

While a number of items are on their agenda, one major proposal is expected to be a voluntary contraction of teams.

A recent report out of Durham Region had the Central Canadian Hockey League's Bowmanville Eagles possibly folding. Others could follow suit.

"We hope to make some decisions," said Chris Tambos, one of four Stouffville Spirit owners. "Things have been on the shelf way too long and some people are getting upset."

Followers of the Spirit need not worry about their team folding.

"There will be a team in Stouffville for sure," Tambos said.

The Spirit will hold its annual spring camp April 30 to May 2 at the Stouffville Arena. Last season's camp helped identify eight players who helped the Spirit improve in the standings by 29 points.

"The key to our success has been our annual spring camp where young players are given the opportunity to stand out among their peers and make an impression on our staff," head coach Craig Donovan said on the team's website. "Each year a number of players attending make the team and it allows us to identify players to watch for the next season."

### McWhinney stars in Alabama

Stouffville Spirit fans enjoyed this movie in 2006: goaltender Dan McWhinney leading the home team to an extended playoff run.

Four years ago, the Sault Ste. Marie, Ont., native led the Spirit to division and conference titles and the Provincial Jr. A finals.

This spring, he has the Huntsville (Alabama) Havoc a win away from the Southern Professional Hockey League championship.

Huntsville leads Mississippi two games to none, with Game 3 tonight in Huntsville.

McWhinney is 6-1 and sports a 1.96 goals against average and .931 save percentage in the postseason.

### Coelho goes from Marlies to Ryerson

Another ex-Spirit goalie got another taste of life as a professional hockey player.

Kori Coelho, 20, served as a backup goalkeeper for the Toronto Marlies when they played an American Hockey League contest against the Hamilton Bulldogs April 1.

Coelho, the Central Canadian Hockey League's 2009-10 East Division most valuable player, was a last-minute call-up when starting netminder Joey MacDonald was recalled by the Anaheim Ducks.

After serving as a practice goalie with the parent Toronto Maple Leafs during the Olympic break, Coelho did not have to think twice.

His one-game amateur tryout contract will not interfere with his plans to play at Ryerson University for Stouffville resident Graham Wise next season.
