Tubing is placed underground below the frost line and a heat pump extracts ground water or an anti-freeze type of solution during the colder months and transfers it to the home's heating system for distribution.

Geothermal heating can be used in homes utilizing air coil or forced air systems with standard duct work.

The system works in reverse for air conditioning.

Today, Earth Day, the Community Mennonite Church of Stouffville is presenting a free public information night in the Parkview Village auditorium, 12184 Ninth Line.

"It's a chance for people who have questions about (solar power and/or energy conservation) to ask questions about it to people who have been through it," Mr. Reesor said.


For people interested in viewing, first-
