Spartans prove they can play with big boys

The big question facing the Stouffville District Secondary School Spartans senior boys' rugby team entering this season was whether they could play at the AAAA level.

The Spartans will compete at the AAAA level due to an increase in school population this year after having been a AA entry in the past.

Taking to the McMaster University pitch to play in a tournament against some of the top AAAA level teams last week, the Spar-

tans alleviated any doubts. In fact, they reached the finals in their eight-team division and gave Lorne Park (Mississauga) a run for its money before surrendering a try on the last play of the

game to lose 7-0.

"This definitely showed that we could play with AAAA-level teams," said Spartans head coach Jamie Hewitt. "In the past we've played against AAAA-level teams, but it would only be in tournaments. Now we'll be seeing them more and more since we're competing at that level.

"There's really not much difference. It shows we're ready."

The Spartans won their opening game over Bradford 22-5.

Brandon Paulino, Atique Wasim, Con-

nor McDonald and Curtis Crago scored for the Spartans. Jesse Lofthouse booted one convert.

Advancing to the semifinal, the Spartans trailed host Saltfleet for most of the game before Lofthouse scored a try on the final play of the match and booted a convert to propel Stouffville to a hard-fought 7-5 win.

Hewitt credited the play of their defence in enabling them to reach the final.

"It was very good," he said. "Our offence is just coming around."

The Spartans' solid defensive play stemmed largely from their recent March break tour to play friendlies against schools from England and Wales.

"It was huge," Hewitt said. "We were used to playing physical teams and the kids told (the Spartans coaching staff) that it wasn't as hard or physical (in the Saltfleet Tournament) as it was when we played in England.

"That tour definitely toughened us up." The Spartans were to have played an exhibition game yesterday in Cannington against Brock High School.

The first league game is slated for April 27 when the defending York Region Athletic Association champions play Markham at Bill Crothers Secondary School in Unionville at 2:30 p.m.

The Stingers prevailed 2-1 (25-17, 18-25, 15-11).






