

ELECTION: Ex-Stouffville mayor

Sainsbury running in third town

You can't keep Fran Sainsbury out of municipal politics.

The former mayor of Whitchurch-Stouffville and Clearview Township is running in a ward in New Tecumseth in the Oct. 25 election.

She is running in the Green Briar and Briar Hill ward, east of Alliston. The current councillor, Dennis Egan, isn't seeking re-election.

Mrs. Sainsbury moved to Briar Hill in December from Clearview, south of Wasaga Beach.

The former Whitchurch-Stouffville citizen of the year was a councillor in Whitchurch-Stouffville from 1982 to 1985 and mayor from 1985 to 1994.

She was mayor of Clearview from 2003-2006.

Did you know? The Brown House . . .



- was built by James Brown between 1850 & 1860
- has unique features such as built-in bedroom closets and an exterior exit door in the dining room
- is significant in Stouffville's history – the papers that incorporated Stouffville as its own village were signed in the dining room in 1877
- was originally located behind the Stouffville Flea Market
- was donated to the Museum in 1984 by a developer and took 7 years to restore
- is restored to represent a typical farmhouse of the 1880s

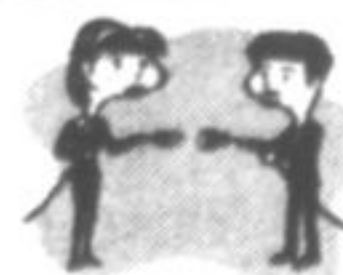

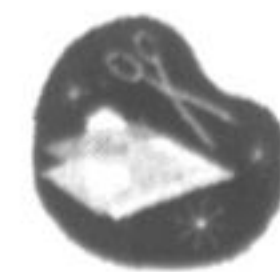
