## Reesor spikes U.S. honours

Justin Reesor ended his four-year volleyball career at Eastern Mennonite University on the First Team North East Collegiate Volleyball Association All-Western Division squad.

The Stouffville resident who plays middle blocker led the Harrisonburg, Virginia, school this past season in blocks with 104, block assists (85) and hitting percentage (.376).

He also averaged 2.22 kills per set and added 19 solo blocks.

He also left his mark on the team by setting a school record for career blocks with 462.

Last season as a junior, the Stouffville District Secondary School graduate was named to the second team NECVA All-Western Division squad.

Named NECVA rookie of the year in 2007, Reesor majored in business administration.

Among boys, Evan Malcolm finished sixth in the senior boys' 110m hurdles and did it in a Stouffville school record time of 17.95 seconds. He also finished 11th in the high jump.

Chris Daniels was seventh in the senior boys' long jump.

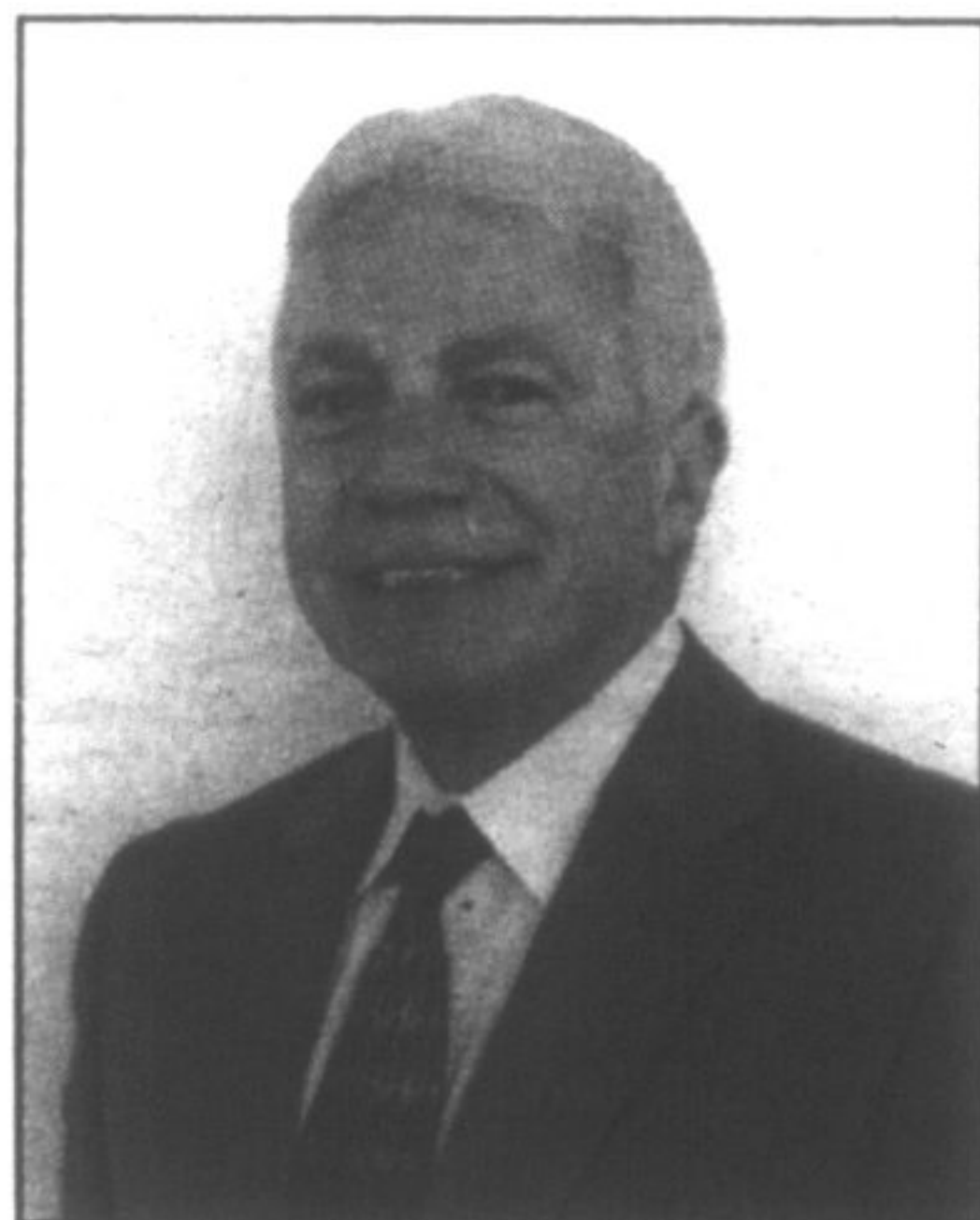
The Spartans are preparing for the York Region championships on May 17 and 18 and the Central Ontario finals May 26 and 27, both at York University.
