Town thanking veterans


Town council is hosting its inaugural Veteran Appreciation Day on June 5.

of course. ... (And) when you're 89 years old and something different comes up, you want to do it."

Unlike Mr. Back, who spent his three years of duty in the combat zones of North Africa, Sicily, Italy and Corsica in a unit that planned air bombings on German vehicles, Mr. Rae stayed on this side of the Atlantic with deployments to British Columbia and Alaska.

"I was a little disappointed" to not be overseas, Mr. Rae said, noting when the war was winding down in 1945, he was granted two weeks leave.

"...when you're 89 years old and something different comes up, you want to do it."

"I was spreading manure when the armistice was signed," the former Whitchurch-Stouffville councillor said with a laugh.

The VE Day celebration takes place at the Canadian Warplane Heritage Museum and will celebrate the end of the Second World War, the 65th anniversary of the Manna food drops into Holland and the 75th anniversary of 424 City of Hamilton Tiger Squadron.
