When Trevor Carrick entered the Stouffville Arena dressing room after taking part in last Saturday's Stouffville Spirit rookie camp he received a text message from his mother.

The news, which was pleasant in nature, did not surprise Carrick, 15, as it confirmed he was drafted in the Ontario Hockey League's annual priority selection.

The Mississauga-St. Michael's Majors took the six-foot, two-inch, 165-pound Carrick 85th overall with their fifth-round pick.

Acknowledging the thought of possibly playing alongside one of his brothers would have been nice, Trevor said it will be just as fun to play against both of them if he can earn a spot on the Majors' roster next season.

"Hopefully I'll get a chance to play a couple of games against them and even hit them," he said with a smile.

The priority selection primarily involved players born in 1994 from Ontario and the northern United States.
