

WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEMS FLUSHING PROGRAM - COMMUNITIES OF BALLANTRAE/ MUSSELMAN LAKE AND STOUFFVILLE

The Public Works Department reminds residents that it conducts a major watermain flushing program of the Town's water distribution systems twice annually.

The work is to be conducted daily, Monday to Friday, between the hours of 9:00 am and 3:30 pm.

The process involves the flowing of fire hydrants for several minutes. The program will remove accumulated sediment from the systems. Some temporary discolouration may occur. The presence of this sediment does not pose a health hazard. Should anyone experience any discolouration of water, please let the water run until it clears. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause. It also allows Public Works crews the opportunity to check the operation of hydrants to ensure that they are in proper working order.

OUTDOOR WATER USE FOR THE COMMUNITIES OF STOUFFVILLE, BALLANTRAE AND MUSSELMAN LAKE WATER DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM

No person shall use the municipal water of the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville from a hose, pipe, sprinkler or permanent water irrigation system for the purpose of watering any lawn, garden or the washing of vehicles, sidewalks or driveways or the filling of swimming pools except as follows:

- a) An EVEN numbered address may use water outdoors ONLY ON EVEN NUMBERED DAYS of the month;
- b) An ODD numbered address may use water outdoors ONLY ON ODD NUMBERED DAYS of the month;
- c) Outdoor water use is only permitted between the hours of 6:00 am to 10:00 am and 6:00 pm to 10:00 pm. This use of municipal water from a hose, pipe sprinkler or permanent water irrigation system outside these periods is a contravention of the by-law.
- d) That these conditions be in place between May 15th and September 30th of each year;
- Exemptions to the above are provided in Schedule "A".
