

The Red Bulb Espresso Bar, which will open this summer at Main and Edward streets, has been approved for a \$5,432 loan under the building facade and sign loan program.

The money will be used to install a window and front entry door.

The loan is half the value of the project's cost and is payable over a maximum of 10 years, interest-free.

The plan encompasses a broad range of financial tools, property acquisition/disposal objectives or business partnerships that have been established to assist in the enhancement or redevelopment of a specific area of the municipality which is in need of assistance/leadership/rejuvenation.
