FILES Del Zotto on NHL all-rookie team

Michael Del Zotto capped off a successful freshman campaign with the New York Rangers by being named to the National Hockey League's 2010 All-Rookie team last week.

A first-round pick of the New York Rangers in the 2008 NHL entry draft, the 19-year-old Stouffville resident compiled nine goals and 28 assists in 80 games during his first-year cam-

paign. Del Zotto finished the season ranked first among all NHL rookies in power play assists with 18, second in power play points with 22 and tied for fifth in power play goals with four.

He also ranked second in the NHL among first-year players in hits with 162, fourth in assists and blocked shots with 92, seventh in points and tied for 15th in goals.

Del Zotto led the Rangers in power play assists, ranked second in power play points, third in assists, tied for fourth in points and ranked fifth in power play goals and eighth in goals.

He also led all team defencemen in goals, assists and points.

In being named to the NHL All-Rookie team, Del Zotto became the first Rangers player to do so since goalkeeper Henrik Lundqvist did it in 2006 and the first skater since Mike York in 2000.




