NOTICE OF THE PASSING OF A DEVELOPMENT CHARGES BY-LAW AMENDMENT

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of The Regional Municipality of York enacted By-law No. 2010-49 on Thursday, June 24, 2010, under the *Development Charges Act*, 1997 ("the Act"), as an amendment to By-law No. DC-0007-2007-040

AND TAKE NOTICE that any person or organization may appeal the By-law to the Ontario Municipal Board under Section 14 of the Act by filing with the Clerk of the Regional Municipality of York, no later than 4:30 p.m. on August 3, 2010, a notice of appeal setting out the objection to the By-law and the reasons supporting the objection.

OVERVIEW

Development charges are levied against new development, and are the primary source for funding growth-related capital expenditures. Regional capital services include water, wastewater, transportation (roads, transit and subway) and general services (police, emergency medical services, capital growth studies, long term care, health, public works). Development charges are imposed against the new development (residential and non-residential lands) at the time of development approvals in accordance with the Act.

LANDS AFFECTED

By-law No. DC-0007-2007-040, as amended, imposes the residential and non-residential development charges against all lands, buildings or structures within The Regional Municipality of York. As the By-law applies to all lands within The Regional Municipality of York, a key map has not been included in this notice.

RESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENT CHARGES

Residential development charges imposed pursuant to By-law No. DC-0007-2007-040, as amended, shall be the amounts applicable at the date of payment as set out in the following schedules:

• In general, development charges are payable upon building permit issuance, except in the case of residential subdivisions where the roads, water and sewer components of the charge are collected upon subdivision agreement. Various prepayment and deferral options are available, depending on the nature of the development. Details can be found on our website at:

 By-law No. DC-0007-2007-040, as amended, authorizes annual indexing of the development charges on the anniversary date of this by-law and each anniversary thereafter, in accordance with the Statistics Canada Quarterly Construction Price index.

• In accordance with the Act and the By-law, certain forms of development are exempt from the payment of regional development charges.

• By-law No. DC-0007-2007-040, as amended, expires June 17, 2012, unless it is repealed at an earlier date.
